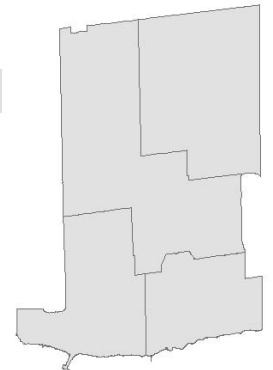

School Boundary Reviews & PARCs

Boundaries are not permanent and may change over time. Boundaries can change as a result of a [boundary review process](#) (generally undertaken to set a boundary for a new school) or as a result of a [Program and Accommodation review](#). Both of these processes are completed in advance of any actual changes to a boundary. Both processes also allow for public information meetings and consultation.

FYI!

Notes About Attendance Boundaries

- An alternate address **cannot be used** (i.e. friend's, parent's or child care provider's address)
- A business/office address **cannot be used**
- Proof of address is required for registration
(lease or purchase agreement or current property tax bill)
- Students granted optional attendance are **not eligible** for Board Transportation
- Full day every day kindergarten programs are **not open** to optional attendance (to view the list of schools offering full day every day kindergarten, [click here](#)).
- The optional attendance procedure does not apply to students placed for special needs

Will they be bussed?

Many families inquire about transportation to school



The HDSB's [Transportation Policy](#) determines eligibility for transportation. To be eligible,

- Kindergarten- Grade 8 students must be living over 1.6 km from the school
- Grade 9-12 students must be living over 4.0 km from the school
