SUBJECT: Notification of Boundary Review for Tiger Jeet Singh PS - Secondary School Boundary Alignment

Dear parents/guardians,

We are writing to inform you of a boundary review discussion for Tiger Jeet Singh PS, to align the elementary and secondary boundaries and transition all Grade 8 students to the same secondary school. Trustees passed the motion below to initiate the process for a boundary review at the March 4, 2025 Halton District School Board meeting.

Please note that you are receiving this notification because you have a child in Grade 7 or below at Tiger Jeet Singh PS and the outcome of the review will impact your child. If Option 1 is approved by the Board of Trustees, your child will attend Craig Kielburger SS starting in September 2026 instead of Elsie MacGill SS when they reach Grade 9. This will allow your child to attend the designated secondary school along with their Grade 8 peers.

Boundary Review Motion Approved by Trustees

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Halton District School Board direct staff to initiate and complete a boundary review for SRA 301 Milton West (formerly SRA 104) and SRA 302 Milton East (Formerly ERA 105) to align pathways for Tiger Jeet Singh PS and eliminate the split Grade 8 cohort created by the approval of option 6a on January 7, 2025.

A Boundary Review Steering Committee made up of trustees and staff was established on April 7, 2025 to determine which pathway to pursue and tentatively review potential options to implement. The committee agreed that a [Pathway 2 process](#) would be suitable for this boundary review and concluded that all students relocated from the former Anne J. MacArthur PS zones to Tiger Jeet Singh PS will

attend Craig Keilburger SS. [Option 1](#) was presented and found to be the most effective for students.

Next steps

This recommendation will be presented to Halton District School Board Trustees on **May 6, 2025** and considered for approval at the **June 3, 2025 Board meeting**.
