Why A Boundary Review?

At the September 18, 2019 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to initiate the process to establish a boundary review for the new Milton SS.

Be it resolved that the Halton District School Board direct staff to recommence a school boundary review for the new Milton SW #1 high school, which will include schools in SRA 101, SRA 104 and SRA 105; with an expected completion date of no later than June 2020.

Purpose of Boundary Review

- Establish a boundary for the new Milton Secondary School
- Review the current boundaries for Milton District High School, Craig Kielburger Secondary School and Dr. Frank J. Hayden Secondary School

Parent Representation on Boundary Review Committee (BRC)

- **TWO** representatives from each school in the affected communities
- Parent Representatives appointed by each School Council
- Meetings are open to the public

Boundary Review Steering Committee

- Determines which schools are part of the boundary review process
- Generates the initial boundary options for consideration
- Recommends the preferred option(s) to Administrative Council and the Director of Education

Boundary Review Committee

- Collaboratively examine the boundary options
- Provide feedback
- Suggest modifications to initial options
- Suggest additional options
- Submit the preferred option(s) to the Boundary Review Steering Committee

Criteria to Measure Impact of Options

- Viability of Program
- Proximity to Schools
- Portables
- Balance of Overall Enrolment
- Long-Term Boundaries
- Transportation
- Fiscally Responsible
- Student Experience
- Other

Boundary Review Process

STEP 1 and 2

- Trustees approve commencement of a boundary review
- The **BRSC** review enrolments, school capacities and programs.
- Initial boundary options are generated.



STEP 3 and 4

- Public announcement of boundary review
- **Boundary Review Committee (BRC)** established and examines initial options, offers suggestions to initial options or suggests new options.



STEP 5

- Public Consultation reviews preferred options.
- **BRC** considers input from community.
- **BRSC** makes possible revisions to the recommendation(s).



STEP 6

- **BSRC** makes recommendation(s) to the Director.
- The Director shares the report with the Board.
- Delegations to the Board.
- **Board of Trustees make the final decision.**



STEP 7

- The Integration Committee is established to develop and implement the positive integration of students and staff

Regional Programs at the new Milton Secondary School


- School will open with grade 9 and 10 students only
