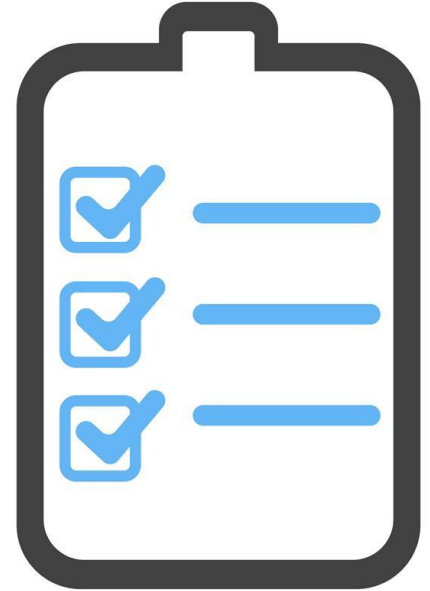
# Honouring the Land and Territory

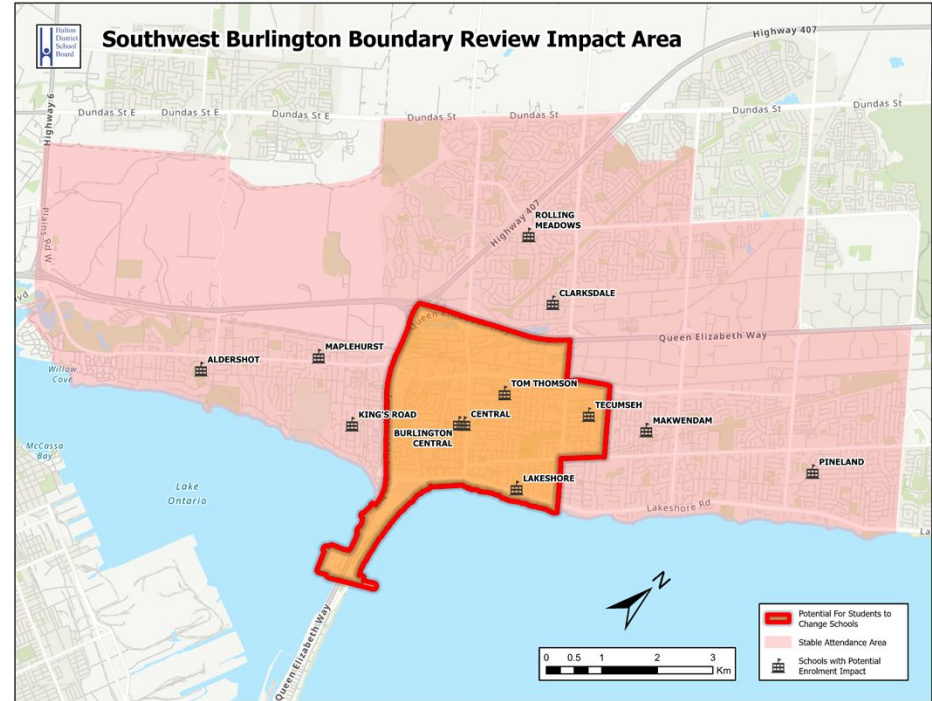
# Southwest Burlington Boundary Study Resolution

## Background:

At the November 4, 2025 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to balance enrolments in Southwest Burlington ([link to report](#) - [link to map](#)).

## Board Report Resolution:

***BE IT RESOLVED THAT,*** That the Board of Trustees direct staff to initiate and complete a boundary review for ERA 101 Aldershot, Parkway Belt, & Downtown Burlington (formerly ERA 100 and 101), ERA102: South QEW Between Guelph & Burloak (formerly ERA 101 and 102), ERA 103 Northwest Burlington to balance enrolments at affected schools within existing and future communities for both the English and French Immersion program.

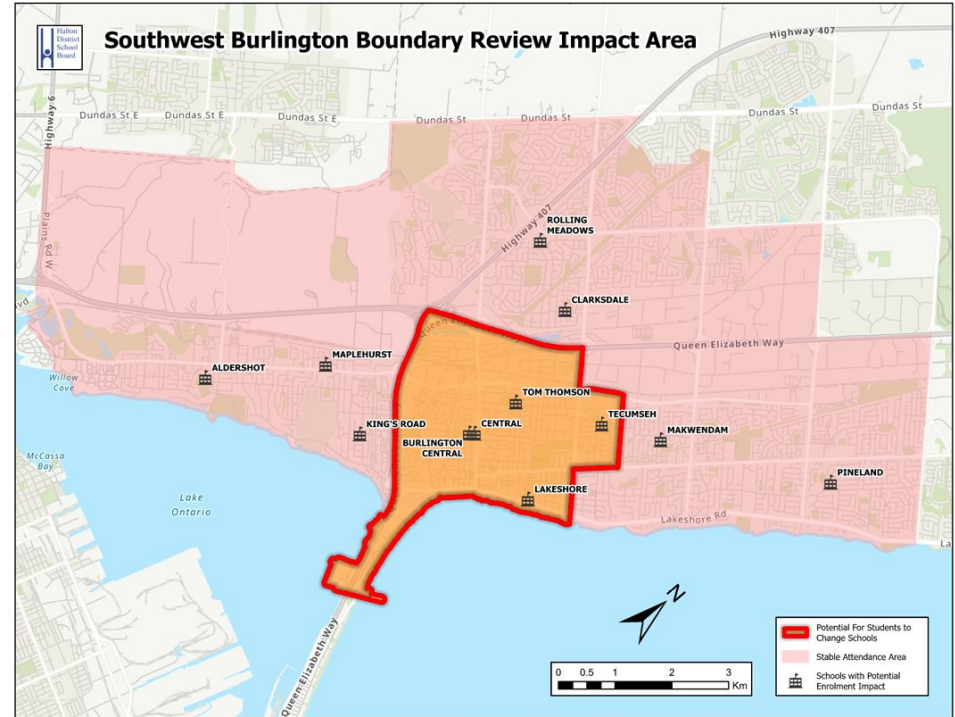


# Administrative Procedure Review

## Purpose of Boundary Review

The mandate of the Boundary Review will be to:

1. Address the over-utilization at Tom Thomson PS for better site utilization
2. To simplify Grade 6 to 7 and Grade 8 to 9 pathways, and reduce split cohorts.
3. Ensure long-term balanced enrolments that minimize the need for temporary accommodations such as portables.
4. Make better use of the underutilized schools.
5. Explore alternative uses for surplus space in elementary schools, in coordination with Facility Services and Planning strategies.



Effective date: September **2027** (earliest)

## Southwest Burlington Elementary School Boundary Review

### Boundary Review Background

The motion, as presented in [Board Report 25122](#), is as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees direct staff to initiate and complete a boundary review for ERA 101 Aldershot, Parkway Belt, & Downtown Burlington (formerly ERA 100 and 101), ERA102: South QEW Between Guelph & Burloak (formerly ERA 101 and 102), ERA 103 Northwest Burlington to balance enrolments at affected schools within existing and future communities for both the English and French Immersion program.

### Objectives of this Boundary Review

At the November 4, 2025, Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to initiate a boundary review process to review the enrolment and boundaries for both the English and French Immersion programs for schools in ERAs 101, 102, and 103. The initiation of this boundary review seeks to achieve the following actions:

1. Address the over-utilization at Tom Thomson PS, and reduce/eliminate the overall number of portables on site.
2. To improve transitions between elementary and middle school, to reduce the number of split cohorts for both the English Track and French Immersion programs.
3. Maximize the use of underutilized spaces, and ensure schools have a long-term healthy enrolment, with minimal reliance on temporary accommodations where possible.
4. Identify potential alternate uses for surplus space in elementary schools within the study area (Facility Services and Planning strategy).

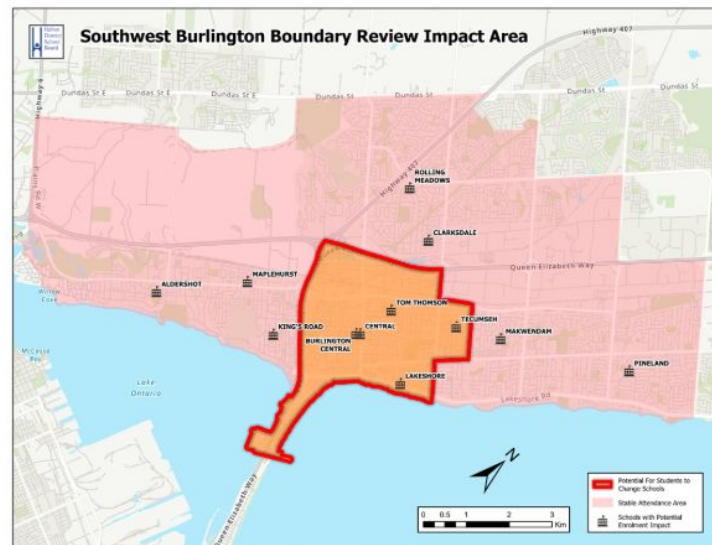

Southwest Burlington Elementary School Impact Area



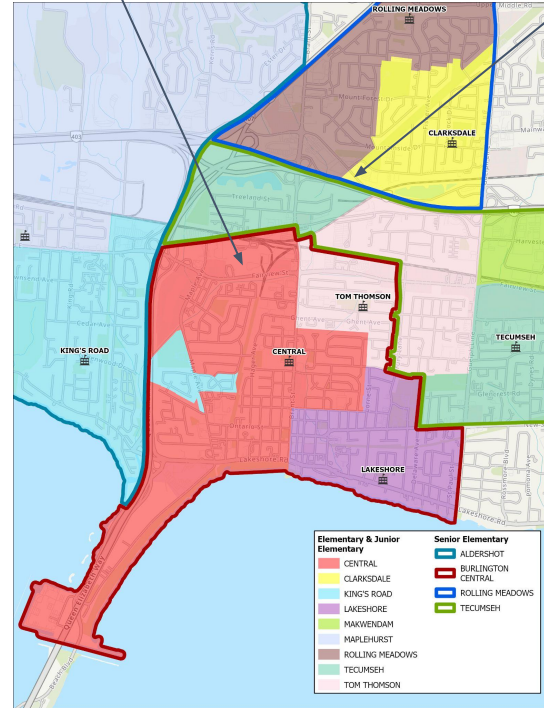
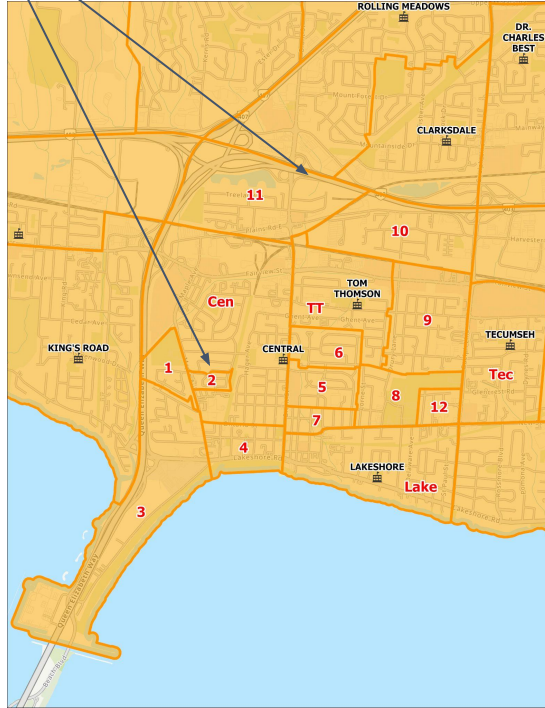

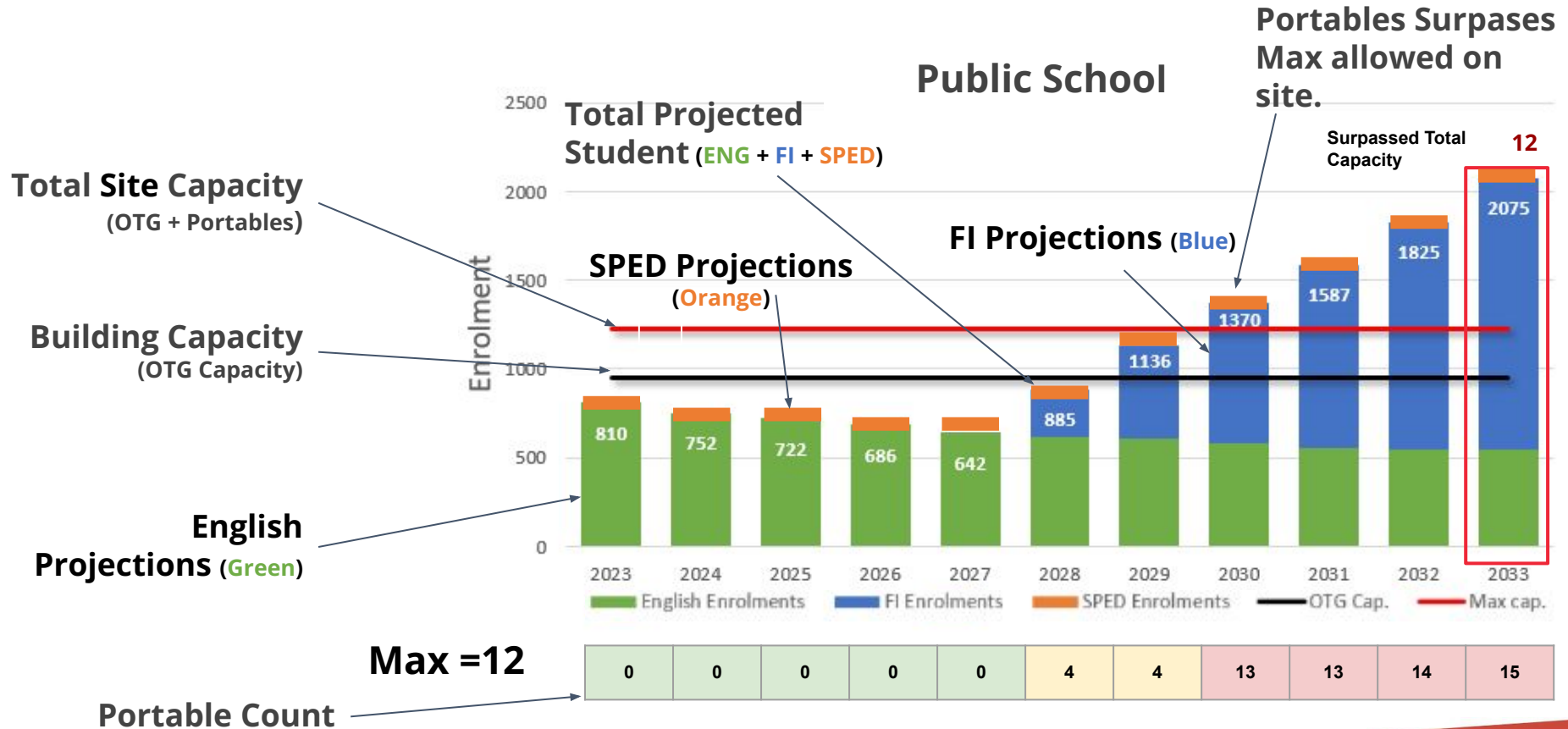

# Assumptions

## Major school and program assumptions

1. New boundaries could be effective as early as Sept 2026, but will more than likely be pushed to 2027. *The final option may include multi-year phasing.*
2. Students west of the QEW are not expected to be redirected.
3. Students north of the QEW are not expected to be redirected.
4. No school will be converted from a K-6 to a K-8 school, unless there are sufficient facilities available on site to accommodate senior grades. This school will have a high retention rate of Grade 7s.
5. A maximum of two schools south and east of the QEW will offer FI. This number can be reduced.
6. Students at dual-track schools opt for French Immersion at higher rates than those at feeder schools.

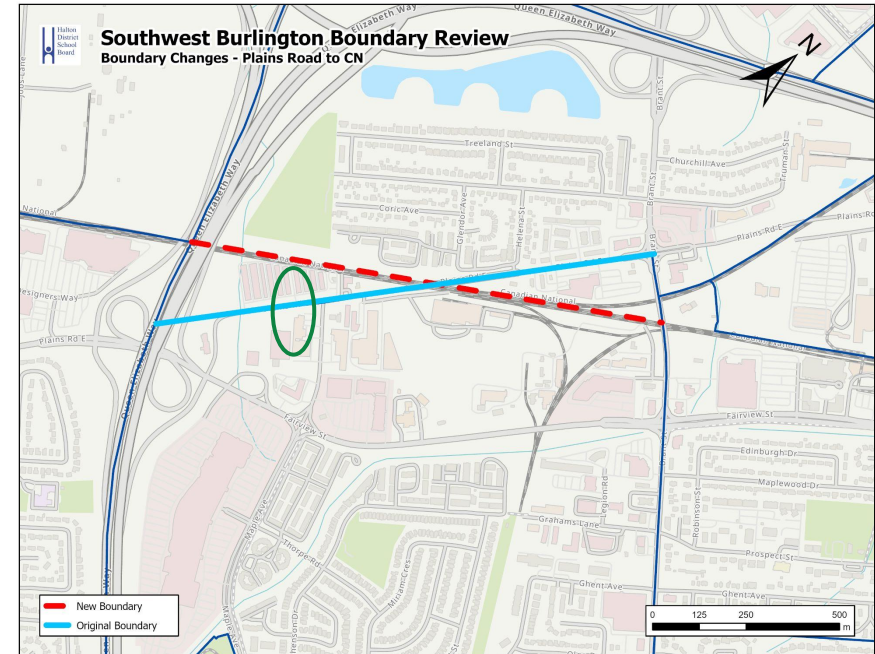
7. Development applications are tied to the English catchment but impact FI.
  - a. 15% of new students will elect FI program. (reflected in projections)
  - b. Potential development is included in the projections for areas with space to develop based on the secondary plan units. impacts schools starting 2035.
8. Boundary reviews don't define which schools will host Special Education programs.
9. ~~All French Immersion students in Grades 2 to 6 will be move (no legacy exemption for Grade 6). Phasing maybe explored.~~

# Assumptions con't

## Major school and program assumptions

10. For schools that are K-6, students entering grade 6 will given legacy exemption and will remain at their current school. *Phasing maybe explored.*
11. Students entering Grades 7 & 8 will be legacy exempt and remain at their current Grade 7 & 8 school.
12. There will be a small boundary adjustment to the existing study area between Central PS and Tecumseh PS to follow the CN Track (red dashed). Note, no elementary students reside in this area.
13. Secondary school will be adjusted to align with final English and French Immersion boundaries as part of a future process.

## Why is my school involved?

Tom Thomson PS is currently operating beyond its capacity, leading to a loss of green space as portables occupy the school grounds. With enrolment projected to approach maximum limits, a boundary review is necessary. Our goal is to balance enrolment across nearby schools by evaluating program locations and attendance boundaries to ensure a high-quality learning environment for all students

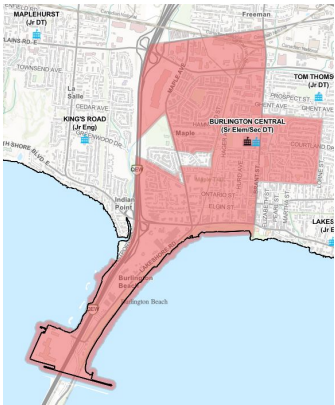
### Current Accommodation Scenario:

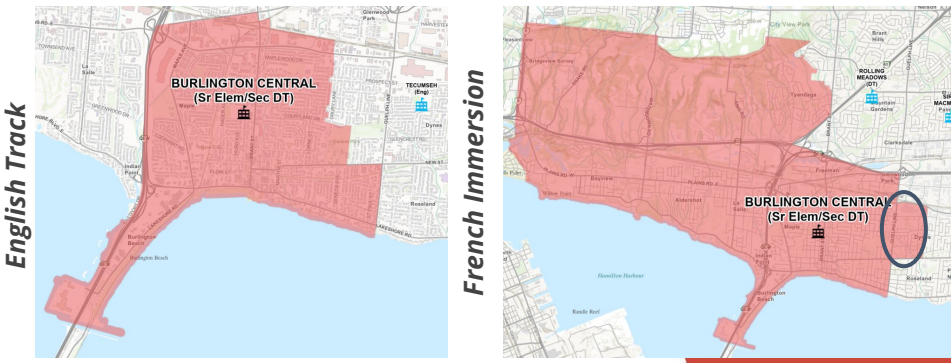

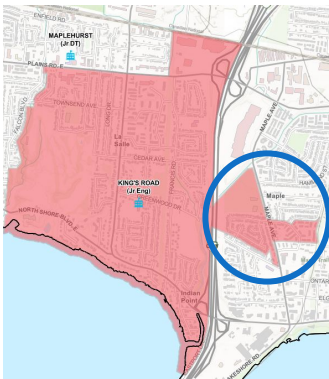

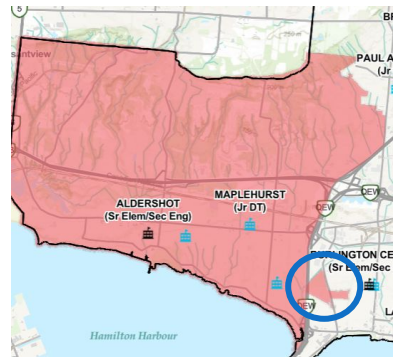

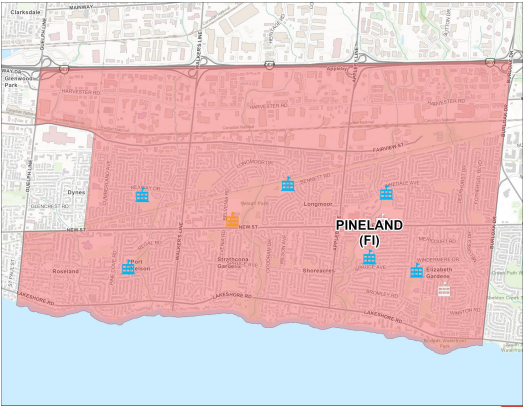
