


# Boundary Review Study Resolution

## Background:

At the December 7, 2022 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to initiate the process to establish new boundaries for Oakville NE #3 PS and Oakville NE #5 PS. ([report](#) - [map](#)).

## Board Report Resolution:

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Halton District School Board direct staff to complete a boundary review for ERA 114 (**Palermo and West Oak Trails**), ERA 115 (**Glen Abbey**), ERA 116 (**Munn's Creek**), ERA 117 (**Morrison Valley**), and ERA 118 (**North Oakville**) with the objective of establishing new boundaries for Oakville NE #3 PS and Oakville NE #5 PS, address accommodation pressures throughout the study area, and update holding school boundaries.




# Boundary Review Study Resolution

## Purpose of Boundary Review

1. Review the current boundaries to establish new boundaries for Oakville NE #3 PS and Oakville NE #5 PS
2. Provide enrolment pressure relief to existing schools, and update the holding schools boundaries.
3. Review the delivery of the English and French Immersion programs.
4. Evaluate current student redirections to Palermo PS from Post's Corners PS and Dr. David R. Williams PS.



- The study area is the area north of Dundas St (ERA 118) and the boundaries of schools south of Dundas St that are currently acting as holding schools. The Grade 2-8 FI program delivery for ERA 118 will also be considered.


## Major Growth Areas and Development Applications within the Study Area

- South of Dundas Street - over 4,000 residential units contained in 14 active development applications





# Oakville NE #3 and #5 PS - status update

## What is the status of the elementary school sites?

- Oakville NE #3 PS is located north of Dundas St, east of Trafalgar Road. The facility is currently under construction and is scheduled to open for September 2025.
- Oakville NE #5 PS is located south of Burnhamthorpe Road, west of Sixth Line. The site has not been purchased and construction has yet to commence, however the school is targeted to open for September 2026 school year.

### About the Boundary Review

At the December 7, 2022 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to review the boundaries of Oakville NE #3 PS and Oakville NE #5 PS, as well as include facilities located in schools in ERA 114 to 117 to address existing accommodation pressures and boundaries in anticipation for future new school facilities in North Oakville.

The motion, as presented in [Board Report 22148](#) is as follows:

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Halton District School Board direct staff to complete the review of the boundaries for [ERA 115 \(Glen Abbey\)](#), [ERA 116 \(Munn's Creek\)](#), [ERA 117 \(Morrison Valley\)](#), and [boundaries for Oakville #3 PS and Oakville #5 PS](#), address Accommodation and boundaries.

Subject to confirmation from the future Boundary Review Steering Committee of the review:

1. ERA 114: Palermo PS (potential holding school)
2. ERA 115: Forest Trail PS (potential holding schools)
3. ERA 116: Munns PS and Sunningdale PS (FI holding schools and potential repatriation and ENG boundary realignment)
4. ERA 117: Falgarwood PS (ENG holding school potential repatriations)
5. ERA 118: Oodenawi PS and Dr. David R. Williams PS (potential ENG and F)

- A non-affected Superintendent and a non-affected Trustee will jointly chair the Boundary Review Committee
- All members of the Steering Committee (for more information see [School Boundary Administrative Procedure](#))
- Parent representatives from all affected communities.

Principals of affected schools are not on the Committee but may be called upon to verify information as required. The BRC is mandated to examine boundary options and to provide feedback. A preferred option(s) will be developed and recommended to the Boundary Review Steering Committee.



<p><b>Viability of Programs: #4</b> <i>Can programs be successfully maintained at the school?</i></p>	<p><b>Proximity to schools:</b> <i>Are safe walk-to opportunities maximized?</i></p>
<p><b>Stable Long Term Boundaries: #3</b> <i>Do projections show long term stability and avoid the need for additional boundary changes in the short term?</i></p>	<p><b>Balance of Overall Enrolment: #2</b> <i>Is access to programs, resources, extra curricular opportunities being maximized? Can over/under utilization be avoided?</i></p>
<p><b>Temporary Accommodation (Portables):</b> <i>Is the use of portable classroom minimized?</i></p>	<p><b>Transportation Requirements:</b> <i>Is this option cost effective for transportation?</i></p>
<p><b>Fiscal Sustainability:</b> <i>Are unnecessary costs avoided?</i></p>	<p><b>Student Experience: #1</b> <i>Does this option minimize the number of student moves? Are cohorts kept together?</i></p>

# Boundary Maps and Zones


- The study area was divided into 38 zones. Two sub zones were created for analysis. (AH north, AH south)
- Zones represent a geographic area, that encompasses a community and/or neighbourhood bound by physical features (e.g. roads, creeks).
- Combination of zones are created to develop boundaries for different options.
- Students that fall within the zones may be *subject to a change* to their home school.



**Zones** are used to visually develop options and help create maps for presentations to BRC members.

# Scenario Assumptions

- ❑ Oakville NE #3 PS opens Sept 2025 (K-7), Oakville NE #5 PS opens Sept 2026 (K-7); Gr8 added the following year
- ❑ Oakville NE #4 ps opens Sept 2030, Oakville NE #6 ps opens beyond the 2033/34 school year
- ❑ Students redirected from Dr. David R. Williams PS and Post's Corners PS to Palermo PS are placed back to their homes schools for 2024
- ❑ Any movement of students assumes Gr8 students remain at current location to graduate with their cohort
- ❑ Need to address the availability of space in existing FI programs south of Dundas Street → no creation of new FI programs
- ❑ Need to address overaccommodation pressures at Post's Corners PS (currently has the maximum of 12 portables) → boundary change required







# Current - Highlights

- **Dr. David R. Williams PS** (JK-8 ENG, 2-8 FI) currently has 24 portables on site is projected to remain above Max Capacity over the next 10 years. This school is currently **closed to new registrations and students are redirected** to Palermo PS.
- **Falgarwood PS** (JK-8 ENG) reaches Max Capacity by 2025 and remains above Max Capacity over the next 10 years. This school is currently a **holding school** for students north of Dundas Street and east of Trafalgar Road.
- **Forest Trail PS** (2-8 FI) is currently at **73% building utilization and is projected to decline** over the next 10 years.
- **Munn's PS** (2-8 FI) is currently at 90% building utilization and is projected to increase to over 100% building utilization by 2028. This school is currently a **holding school** for students north of Dundas Street and east of Trafalgar Road.
- **Oodenawi PS** (JK-8 ENG) currently has 12 portables on site. This school is **projected to decline over the next 10 years but will continue to require portables**.
- **Palermo PS** (JK-8 ENG, 208 FI) is currently at **83% building utilization and is projected to decline** over the next 10 years. This school is currently the school for redirected Dr. David R. Williams PS and Post's Corners PS students.
- **Post's Corners PS** (JK-8 ENG) currently has 12 portables on site is projected to remain above Max Capacity over the next 10 years. This school is currently **closed to new registrations and students are redirected** to Palermo PS.
- **River Oaks PS** (JK-8 ENG) reaches Max Capacity by 2024 and remains above Max Capacity over the next 10 years. This school is currently a **holding school** for students north of Dundas Street and west of Trafalgar Road.
- **Sunningdale PS** (2-8 FI) is currently at 82% building utilization and is projected to remain stable over the next 10 years. This school is currently a **holding school** for students north of Dundas Street and west of Trafalgar Road.




# Current - FI Boundary


# Option 7 - Highlights

- Oakville NE #3 PS opens Sept 2025 as a JK-7 ENG school, Grade 8 added to the following year
  - ENG students within the Oakville NE #3 PS boundary will remain at their current school until school opens
- Oakville NE #5 PS opens Sept 2026 as a JK-7 ENG school, Grade 8 added the following year
  - ENG students within the Oakville NE #3 PS boundary will remain at their current school until school opens
- Dr. David R. Williams PS becomes a single track JK-8 ENG school
  - In Sept 2024, Grade 2 to 5 FI students move to Forest Trail PS/Sunningdale PS, Grade 6 to 8 FI students remain at Dr. David R. Williams PS until graduation
- Post's Corners PS and River Oaks PS new boundaries (south of Dundas St) implemented starting Sept 2025
  - In Sept 2025, JK to 5 ENG Post's Corners students in **Zones AH north and AI** move to River Oaks PS, Grade 6 to 8 ENG students remain at Post's Corners PS until graduation
- **Zone B** - In Sept 2024, JK-7 ENG students move from River Oaks PS to Palermo PS, Grade 8 ENG remain at River Oaks PS until graduation
- **Zone H** - In Sept 2024, JK-5 ENG students move from Dr. David R. Williams PS to Oodenawi PS, Grade 6 to 8 ENG remain at Dr. David R. Williams PS until graduation
- **Zones X, Y and Z** - In Sept 2024, JK-7 ENG students move from River Oaks PS to Falgarwood PS, Grade 8 ENG remain at River Oaks PS until graduation




## NE Oakville #3 and #5 PS Boundary Review 2023 Option 7 English Catchment Boundaries







# Option 7 - FI Boundary



In **Zone Q**, starting Sept 2025:


- River Oaks PS and Falgarwood PS students (JK-7 ENG) move to Oakville NE #3 PS; Grade 8 ENG students remain at their respective schools
- There are currently 231 River Oaks PS and 16 Falgarwood PS students (JK-8 ENG) in this zone

In **Zone T**, starting Sept 2025:

- Falgarwood PS students (JK-7 ENG) move to Oakville NE #3 PS; Grade 8 ENG students remain at Falgarwood PS
- There are currently 64 Falgarwood PS students (JK-8 ENG) in this zone

Note that **Zones R, S, U, V, W, X, Y, and Z** are holding zones for the future Oakville NE #4 PS anticipated for 2030.

Note that there is no impact to FI students and they continue to attend Munn's PS.




# OPT 7 - NOTE #2 - Zones C, D, E, F, I, J, K, O and P move to Oakville NE #5 PS

In **Zones E and O**, starting Sept 2026:

- River Oaks PS students (JK-7 ENG) move to Oakville NE #5 PS; Grade 8 ENG students remain at River Oaks PS
- There are currently 27 and 45 River Oaks PS students (JK-8 ENG) in **Zones E and O** respectively
- Note that there is no impact to FI students and they continue to attend Sunningdale PS


