in September 2024 or later

19 compulsory credits

Students must earn the following compulsory credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma:						
4	credits in English (including NBE3): <i>1 credit per grade</i>					
3	credits in Mathematics: <i>at least 1 credit in grade 11 or 12</i>					
2	credits in Science					
1	credit in Canadian History					
1	credit in Canadian Geography					
1	credit in the Arts					
1	credit in Health and Physical Education					
1	credit in French as a Second Language					
1	credit in Grade 9 or 10 Technological Education					
0.5	credit in Career Studies					
0.5	credit in Civics and Citizenship					
Plus one credit from each of the following groups:						
1	Group 1: an additional credit in English (including the OSSLC), or French as a Second Language, or Native Languages, or First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Studies, or American Sign Language as a Second Language, or a Classical or an International Language, or Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance and Career Education, or Co-operative Education					
1	Group 2: an additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or French as a Second Language, or American Sign Language as a Second Language, or Co-operative Education					
1	Group 3: an additional credit in Science, or Technological Education, or French as a Second Language, or American Sign Language as a Second
