


What option do you prefer?


French immersion /English stream division and class size impacts (avoiding split grade classes)

Make sure as many kids as possible can walk and bike to school. Even if they are in the bus zone grades 5 and 6 walk and bike from Western Aldershot to Glenview.



Option 2 - Boundaries

Option Summary:

1. Students east of Unsworth Ave. (North and south of Plains Rd) to remain at Glenview PS.
2. Students west of Unsworth Ave. (North and south of Plains Rd) to attend Maplehurst PS.
3. Future development in Aldershot Corners to attend Glenview PS
4. Phased transition to Maplehurst PS starting with students in grade K-5
5. **Approximately 105 students to be redirected to Maplehurst PS.**
