4.1 Superintendent's Report

- 1. **Summer Learning Grant:** Ministry has provided \$220 000 to support summer learning and transitions. Permits us to hire educational assistants to support students in summer learning programs offered through School Programs and Gary Allan.
- Transitions: We will use \$140 000 of the Summer Learning REP for student transitions in August. This will provide an opportunity for schools to organize student visits, case conferences and other planning in late August to receive students for the 2025-26 school year.
