#### **ESL Accommodations**

All students in the ESL program (or previously in ESL) are allowed accommodations in <u>all their classes.</u>

#### **Accommodations Include:**

- Extra time on tests and assignments
- Use of a translator or bilingual dictionary
- Vocabulary lists
- Questions reworded or explained by the teacher

## Important Information to Consider

- ESL Courses count as regular credits. Students require 30 credits to graduate.
- ESL Students can choose university, college, or workplace level courses for their non-ESL courses.
- ESL students will not fall behind, because they can take two English courses each school year. (one per semester)
- Buses are provided for ESL students who are Step 1-3 and live more than 3.2 kilometers from CKSS.

# What Parents Can Do To Help Their Children

- Continue to develop your first language at home.
- Encourage reading all year long (this includes Summer!)
- Encourage students to get involved in after-school activities
- Stay in contact with teachers. Come in for parent evenings. Email us or call us with any questions
- Try not to plan family trips that begin before school ends in June. June is an extremely important month.
