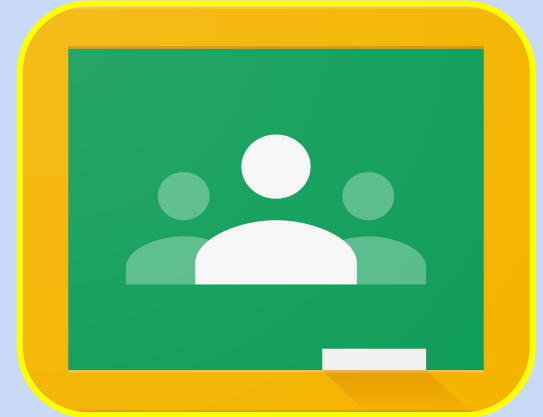
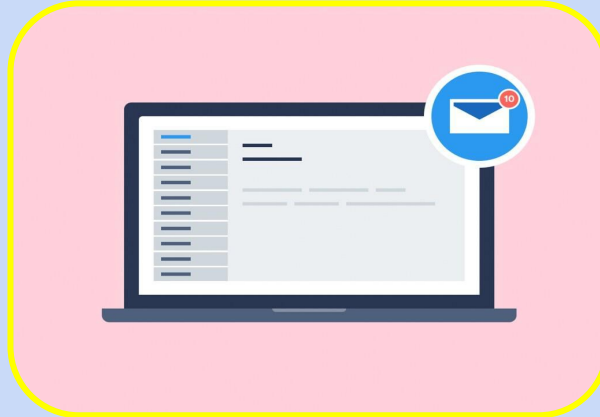

French

In French, we are focused on developing oral communication skills by reciting songs, poems, stories and by learning new vocabulary.

We will be starting with the french sounds and phonemes, then we will move on to reading, writing, speaking and listening.

Math

The math curriculum is organized in 5 areas:

Social Emotional Learning skills being taught through Number, Data, Spatial Sense, Algebra, and Financial Literacy.

Science, Social Studies, Health and Art

In Science we learn 4 units: States of Matter, Air & Water, Growth and Changes in Animals and the Simple Machines.

In Social Studies we learn 2 big units: Changing Family and Community Traditions and Global Communities.

In Health we cover: Safety at home and school, growth and development, healthy eating, teeth

In Art we are exploring: the elements of art, famous artists and art as it relates to world events and celebrations.
