1. Land Acknowledgement

- Opened the meeting with Honour the Land.

2. Agenda Review

- Reviewed the agenda.

3. Participants

- Participant list was reviewed and documented.

4. Purpose of the Meeting

- To resolve misalignments caused by the last Milton South - Milton SE #13 boundary review implementations.
 - A split grade 8 cohort was created where the majority of students are directed to Craig Kielburger SS, with a handful of students attending Elsie MacGill SS.
- Clarified that this does **not** impact current Grade 8 students.
- Changes will be **effective September 2026**.

5. Boundary Review Procedure

- Administration procedure was reviewed.
- Communication strategy includes:
 - Quick updates.
 - Dedicated webpage.
 - Notification to impacted families.

6. Boundary Review Overview

- Focused on the repatriated areas of Tiger Jeet Singh PS and aligning secondary boundaries for Grade 8 cohort.
- Reviewed school profiles and projections:
 - Craig Kielburger SS is projected for enrolments to decline.
 - Elsie MacGill SS is projected to have stable enrolments.
 - Since this split cohort impacts a small number of students it is better for students to remain with their cohort.

7. Staff Recommendation

- Recommendation does not impact current Grade 8 students.
- Grade 8s in 2025/26 school year will receive option sheets for **Craig Kielburger Secondary School (CKSS)**.
- Discussion around optional attendance:
 - Students can apply for optional attendance if desired.

. Pathway Discussion

- Based on the scope, **Pathway 2** is preferred, Pathway 1 deemed too onerous for this review..
- Elementary review was clear in documentation and the Board report that this boundary review is required..
- **Consensus** reached to proceed with Pathway 2.
- Only impacted schools are Craig Keiburger SS and Elsie MacGill SS.
