COPYRIGHT: FAIR DEALING

1. OBJECTIVE

The Halton District School Board respects both user rights relating to the use of copyrighted materials and copyright protection of the moral interests of creators and the economic and distribution rights of creators and content providers.

2. POLICY

As such, the Halton District School Board will comply with the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* as developed by the Council of Ministers of Education Canada (CMEC) Copyright Consortium.

3. SPECIFIC DIRECTIVES

The Halton District School Board will communicate the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* to all school locations on an annual basis in order to ensure that all staff understand the obligations of the school board in accordance with the *Copyright Act*.
