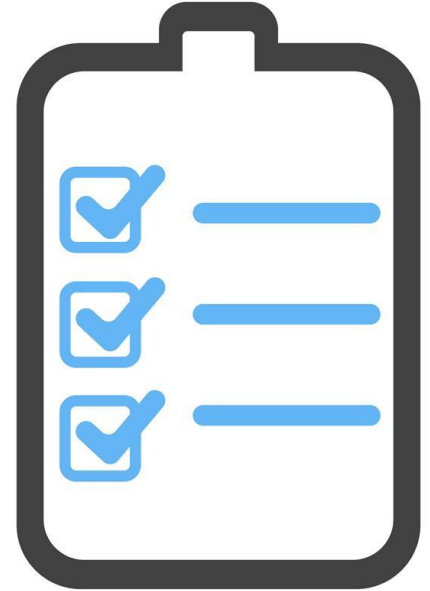
Honouring the Land and Territory

At the November 4, 2025 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion initiate the Oakville NE #1 Secondary School and French Immersion Review ([link to report](#) - [link to map](#)).

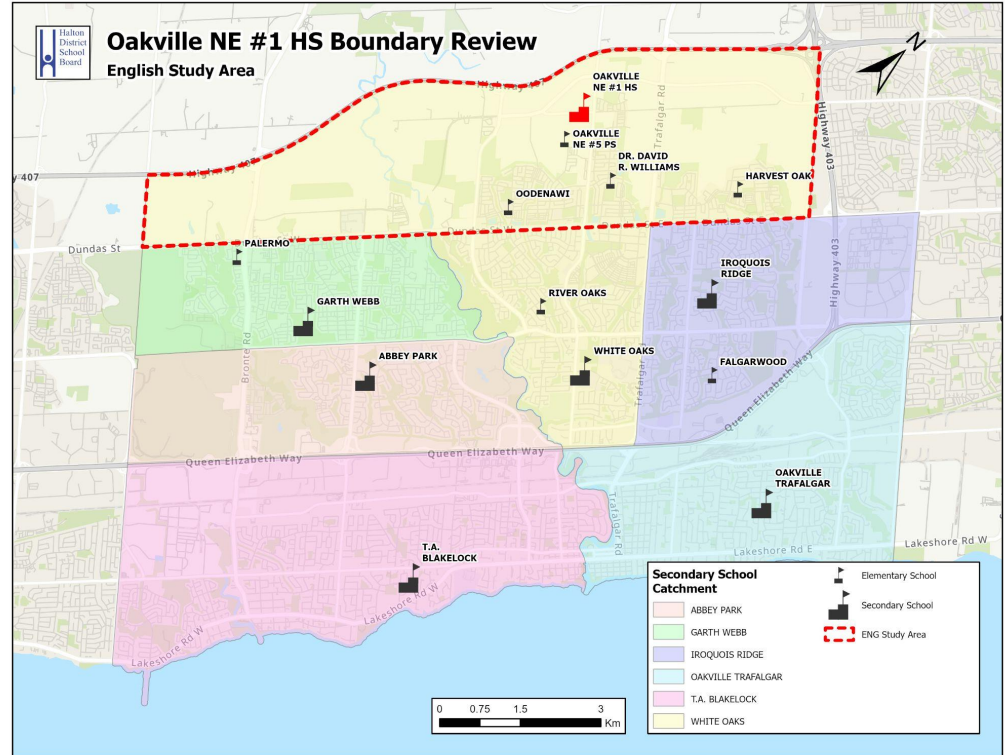
Board Report Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, *That the Board of Trustees direct staff to initiate and complete a boundary review for SRA 201 South of Dundas Oakville (formerly SRA 102 and 103) and SRA 202 North of Dundas Oakville (Formerly SRA 108) to establish a new secondary school boundary for the new Oakville NE #1 Secondary School and to review the distribution of the French Immersion Programs.*

Administrative Procedure Review

Purpose of Boundary Review

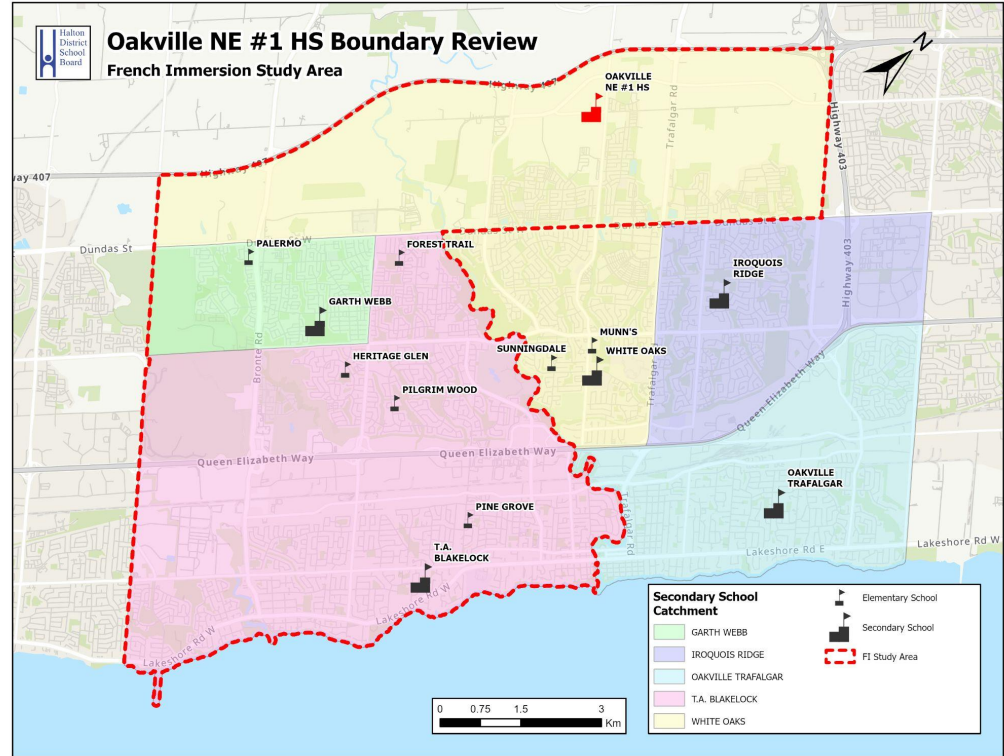
- The primary mandate of the Boundary Review is to establish new boundaries for Oakville NE #1 HS.
- The review is expected to conclude by Spring 2026 in order to implement the new boundaries for the 2027/2028 school year and to notify impacted Grade 8 students (as of 2026/2027 school year).
- Implementation of new boundaries is **September 2027** (earliest) which is in line with the scheduled opening of Oakville NE #1 HS.



Administrative Procedure Review

Purpose of Boundary Review

- The review will also consider whether a new French Immersion program at Oakville NE #1 HS is warranted and if the realignment of FI program boundaries of Oakville secondary schools is required.
- This will include the review of the viability of the FI program at T.A. Blakelock HS which has been declining over the last 10 years.
- The implementation of new FI boundaries can begin as early as **September 2026**.

Boundary Review Background

The motion, as presented in [Board Report 250122](#) is as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees direct staff to initiate and complete a boundary review for SRA 201 South of Dundas Oakville (formerly SRA 102 and 103) and SRA 202 North of Dundas Oakville (Formerly SRA 108) to establish a new secondary school boundary for the new Oakville NE #1 Secondary School and to review the distribution of the French Immersion Programs.

Objectives of this Boundary Review

At the November 4, 2025 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to initiate a boundary review process to create the boundary for Oakville NE #1 HS (SRA 202). The initiation of this boundary review seeks to achieve the following actions:

1. Create a new boundary for the Oakville NE #1 HS, currently holding at White Oaks Secondary School;
2. Realign the French Immersion Boundaries for school facilities south of Dundas, and consider whether a new FI program at the new school is warranted;
3. Review the viability of the secondary French Immersion program at T.A. Blakelock High School, as enrolment and participation have been decreasing year over year; and,
4. Consider the long-term accommodation needs of the Board, and what initiatives could be housed at the White Oak Secondary School North Campus.

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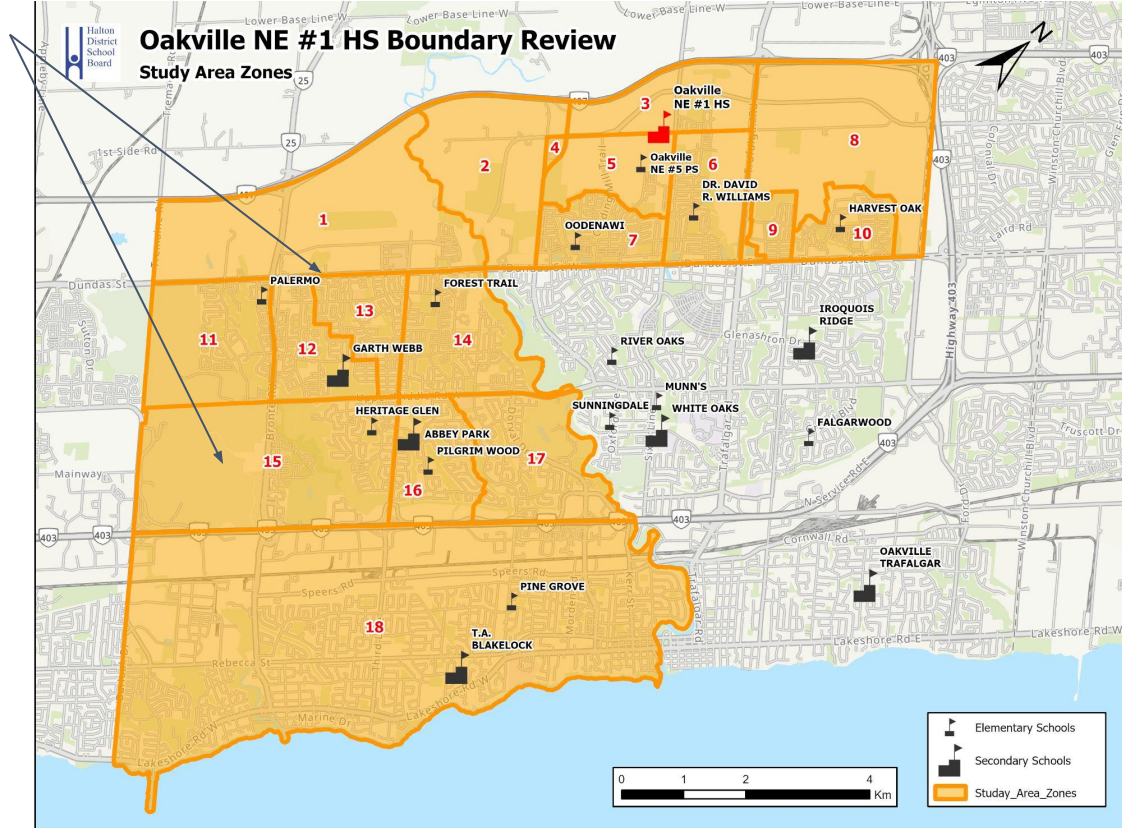

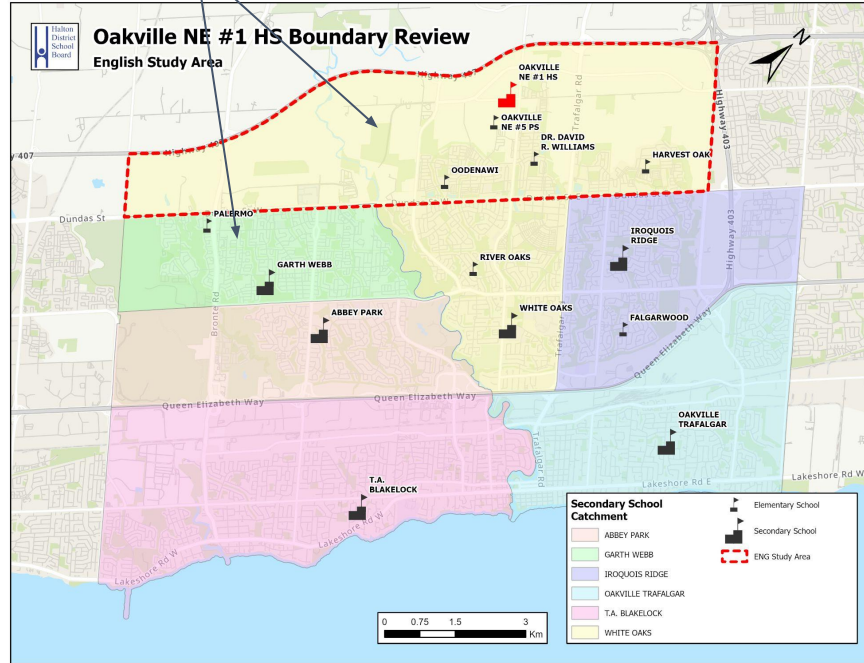

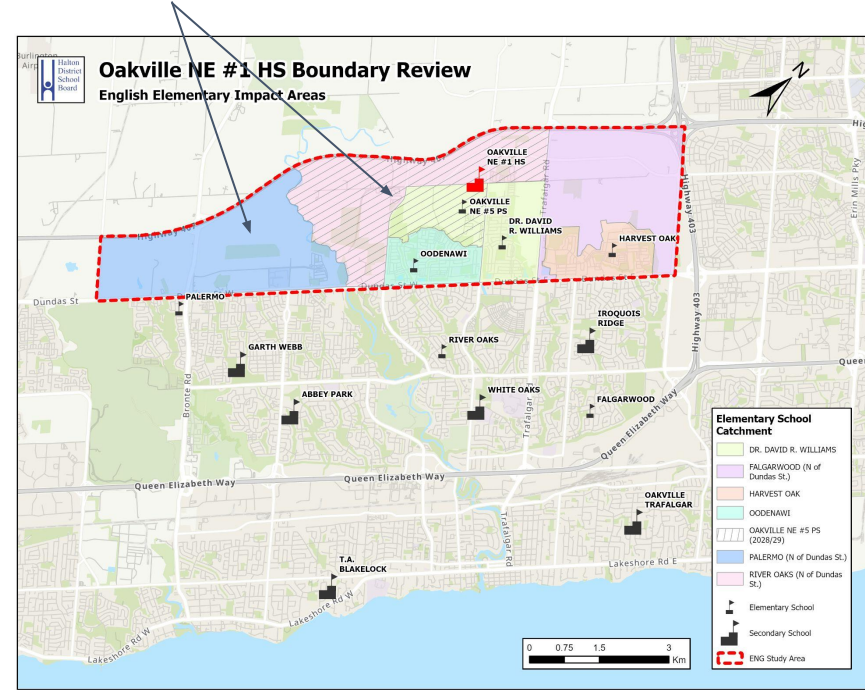

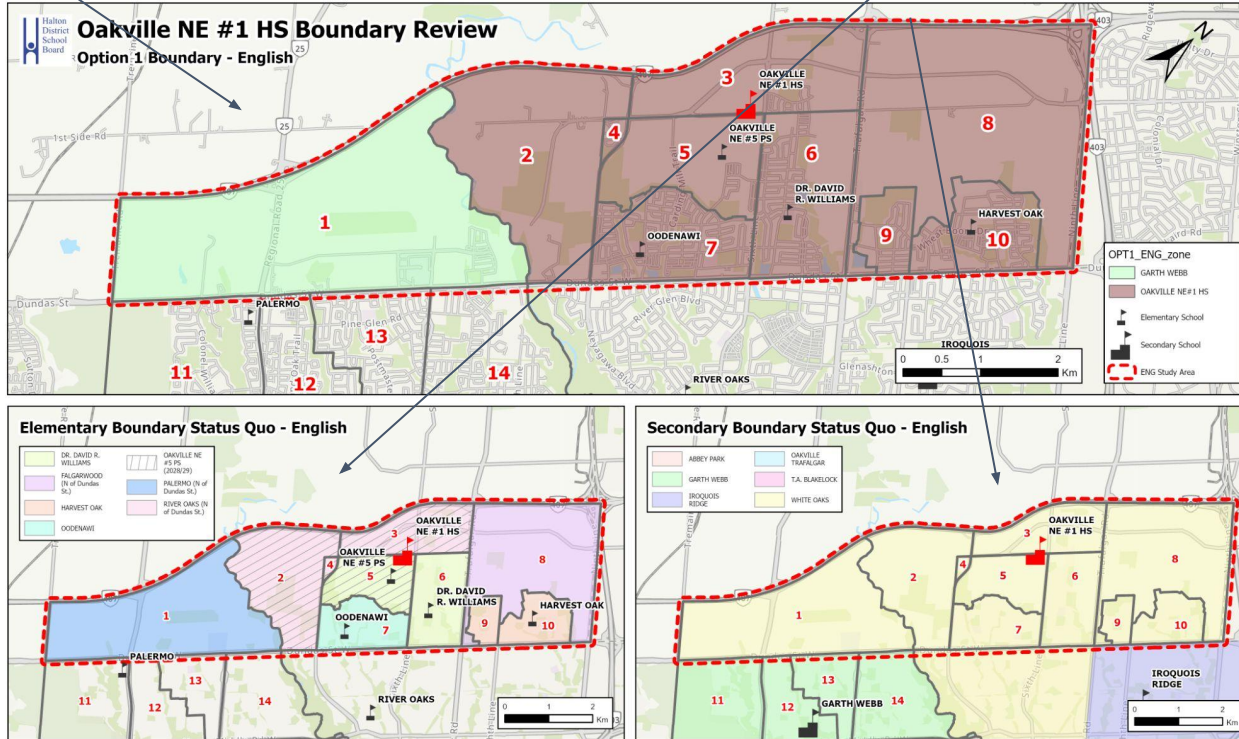

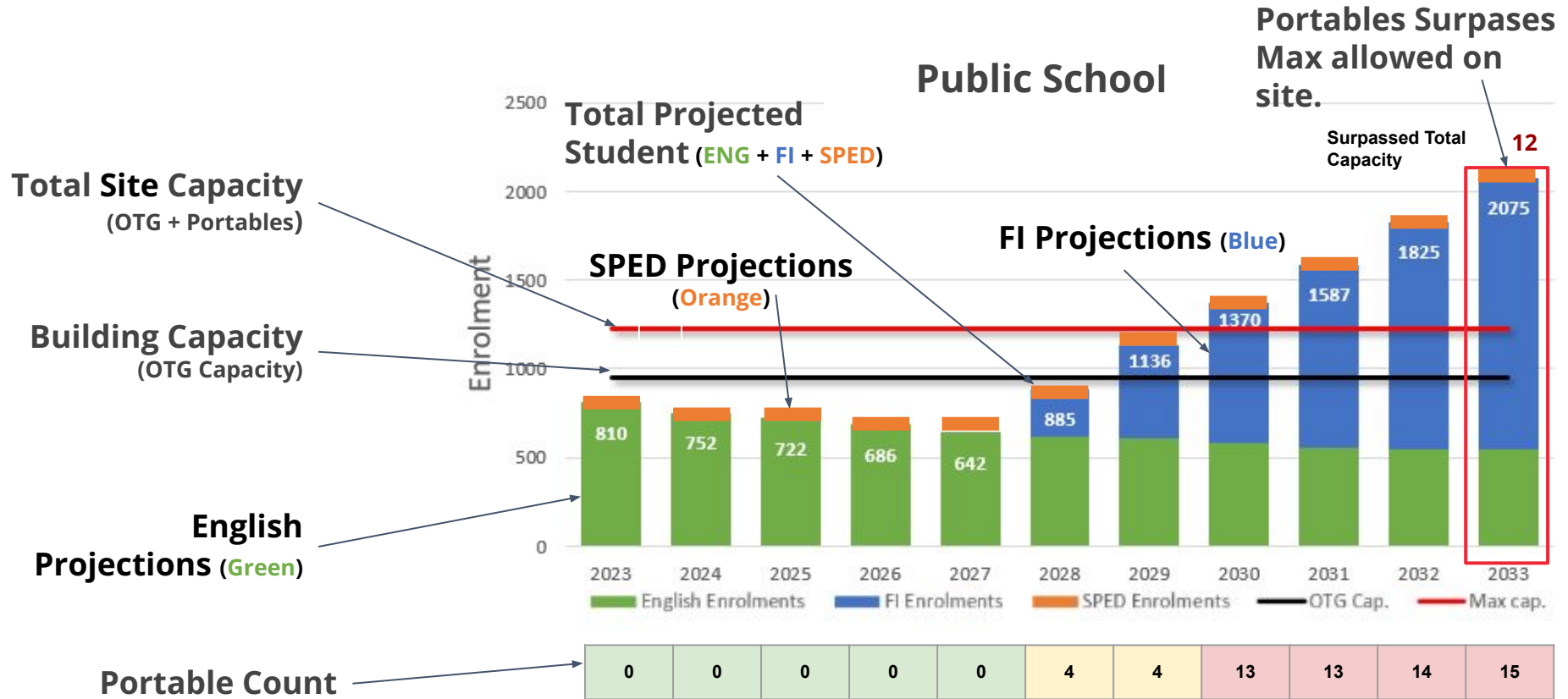

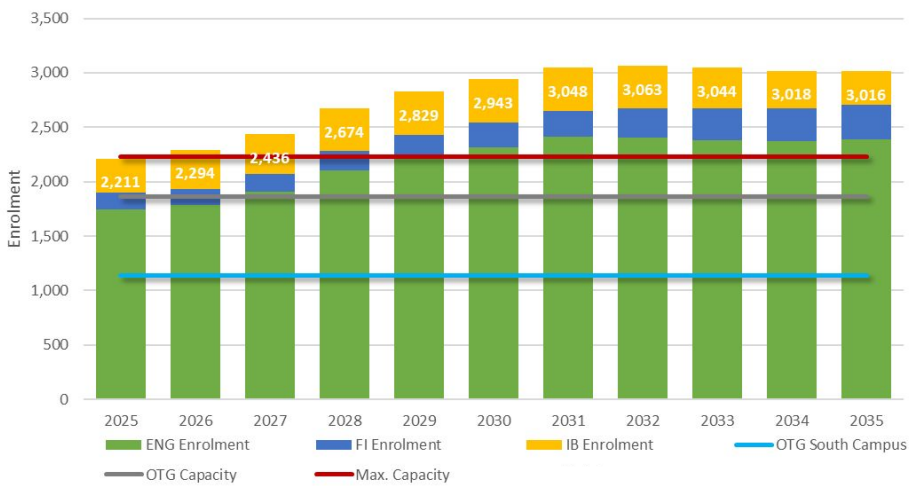
Why is my school involved?

Oakville NE #1 HS is scheduled to open Sept 2027 and a boundary review is required to establish the boundary. Secondary school students north of Dundas St are currently holding at White Oaks SS for English and FI. When Oakville NE #1 HS opens, it is assumed that the area north of Dundas St will form part of the boundary for the new school.

Current Accommodation Scenario:

White Oaks SS is projected to above Total Capacity by 2028 (Status Quo scenario where Oakville NE #1 HS does not open) as a result of growth from new development north of Dundas St. Note that ENG projection includes LDv and CPP numbers.

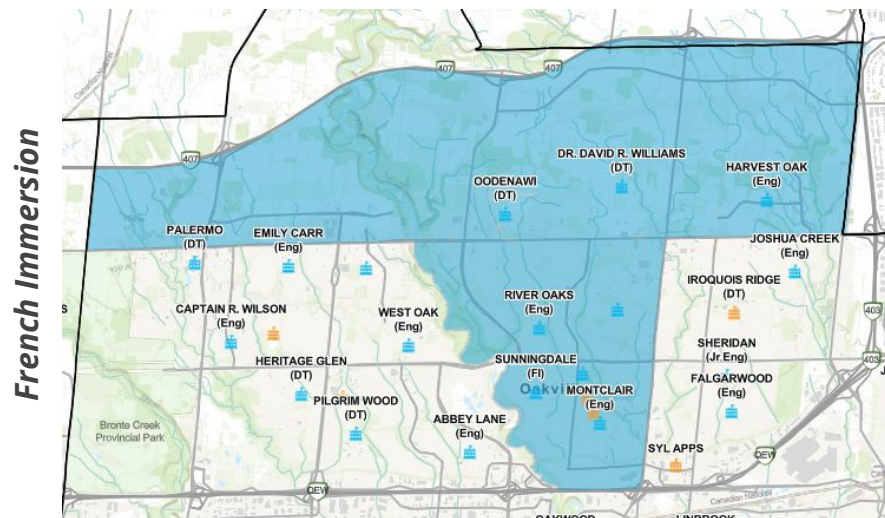
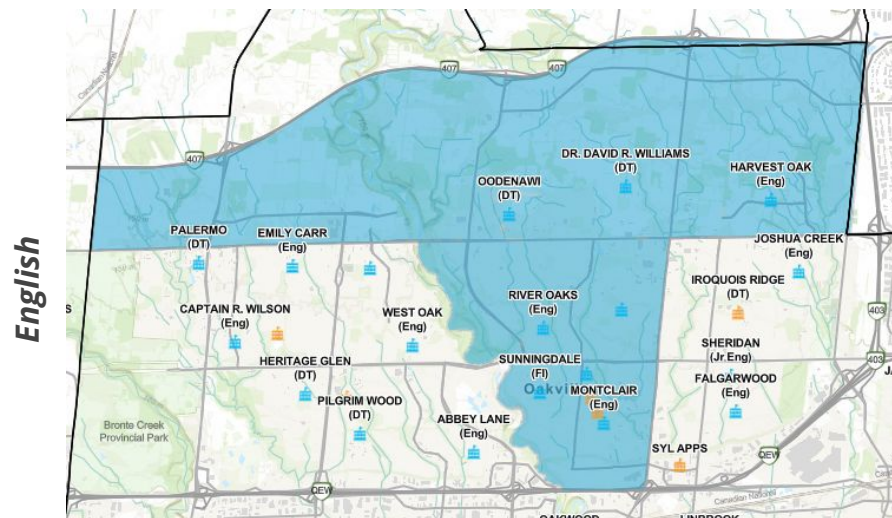
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Current Accommodation Scenario (con't):

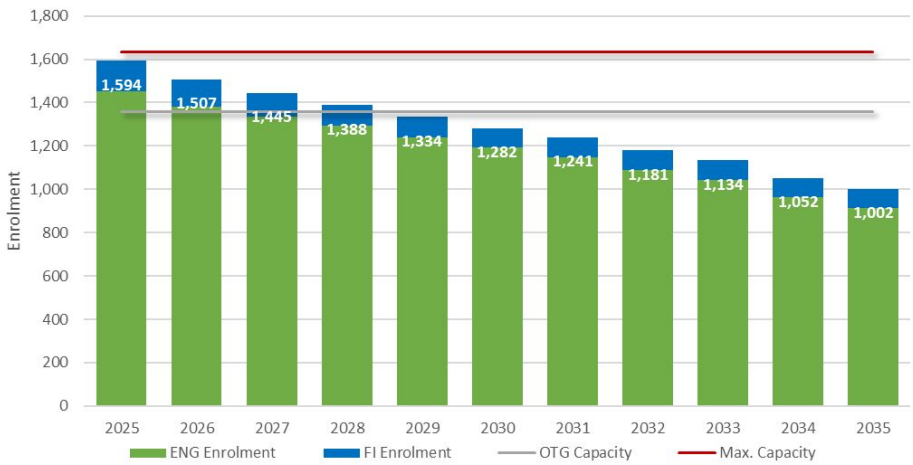
Why is my school involved?

Oakville NE #1 HS is scheduled to open Sept 2027 and a boundary review is required to establish the boundary. Garth Webb SS may be impacted where some areas north of Dundas St may be directed south of Dundas St to Garth Webb SS.

Current Accommodation Scenario:

Garth Webb SS is currently above Total Capacity but is projected to decline to under OTG Capacity within the next 10 years. Palermo PS is one of the Grade 8 feeder schools to Garth Webb SS (south of Dundas) for English and French Immersion which has split cohorts for English and French Immersion. There may be opportunities to align cohorts.

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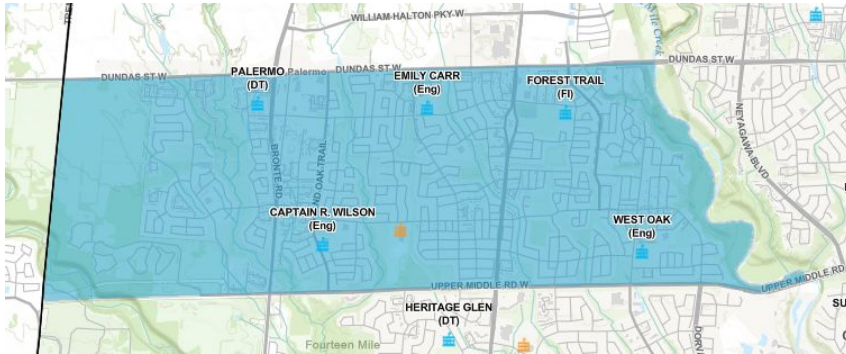

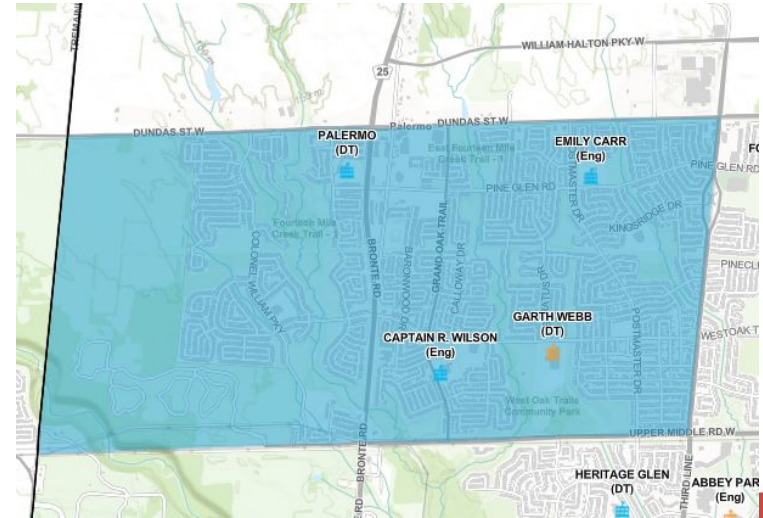

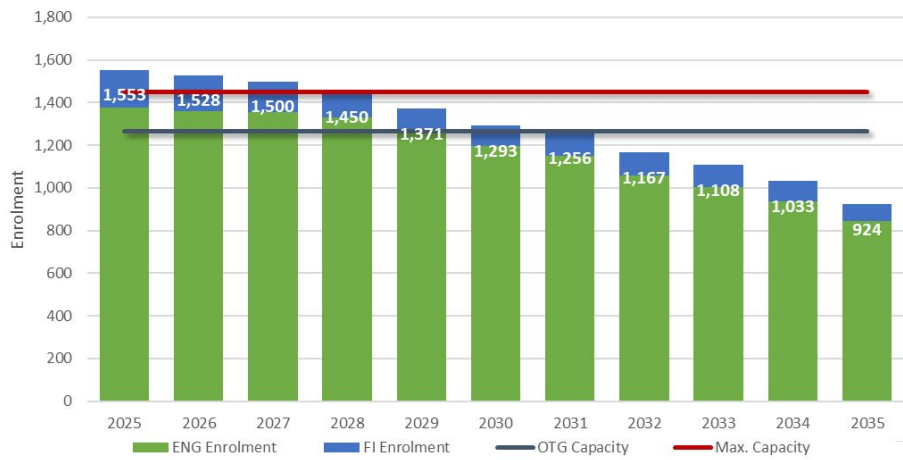
Why is my school involved?

Oakville NE #1 HS is scheduled to open Sept 2027 and a boundary review is required to establish the boundary. Iroquois Ridge HS may be impacted where some areas north of Dundas St may be directed south of Dundas St to Iroquois Ridge HS, specifically for the FI program where there are split cohorts.

Current Accommodation Scenario:

Iroquois Ridge HS is currently above Total Capacity and is projected to decline to under 100% OTG utilization within the next 10 years. Munn's PS is one of the Grade 8 feeder schools to Iroquois Ridge HS (south of Dundas) for French Immersion which has split cohorts for English and French Immersion. There may be opportunities to align cohorts.

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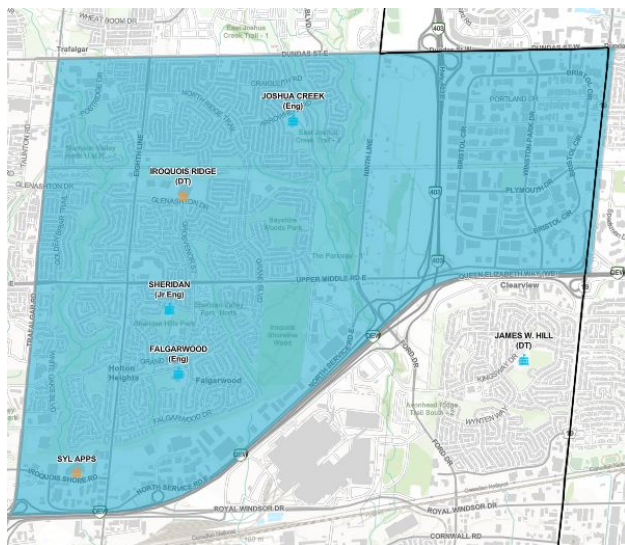

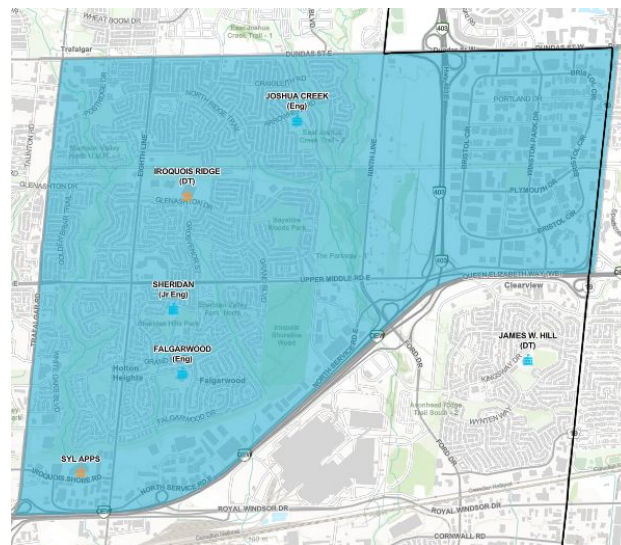

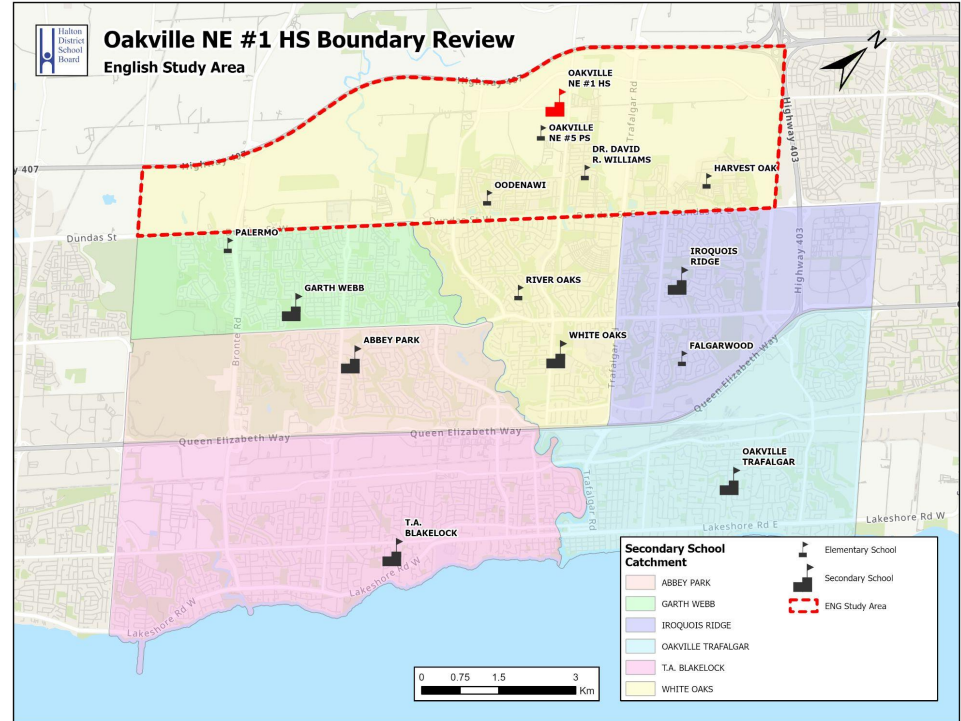

Assumption - Primary Mandate

Primary Mandate - determining the Oakville NE #1 HS boundary

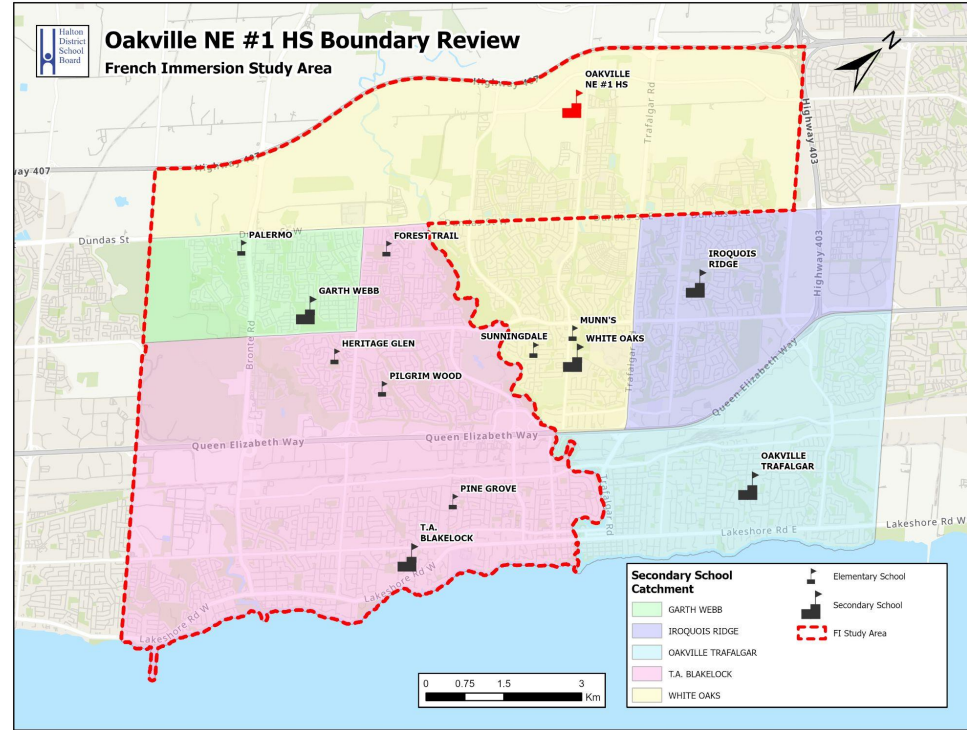
1. New boundaries are effective Sept 2027 at the earliest, *any final option may include multi-year phasing.*
2. Oakville NE #1 HS will contain an English program and Community Pathways Program (CPP); a French Immersion program will not be considered for this review (may be considered at a future date).
3. Special Education Services will defining the CPP boundary for Oakville NE #1 HS.
4. English and French Immersion secondary students south of Dundas St are not impacted.
5. Elementary schools - It is not the intention of this review to change the boundaries or programs of the participating elementary schools but to change the ultimate secondary home school.



Assumption - Primary Mandate

Mandate - realignment of secondary school FI boundaries (south of Dundas St)

1. After review by Board staff, it is determined that the FI program at T.A. Blakelock HS is not a viable program. The following has been determined:
 - a. Since 2020, the program has declined from 196 students to 61 students.
 - b. Some FI elementary feeder schools are sending zero (0) students to T.A. Blakelock HS Gr 9 FI.
 - c. Assuming current progression rules for Gr 8 FI to Gr9 FI, the FI program at T.A. Blakelock HS is projected to remain around 60 students.
2. Proposed boundary change is to phase out the FI program at T.A. Blakelock HS, starting with Gr9 in Sept 2026 and direct to Garth Webb SS. Current FI students at T.A. Blakelock HS can remain at T.A. Blakelock HS until graduation.



Boundary Review - FI Realignment

FI secondary school realignment (south of Dundas St)

Why is this being reviewed?

- T.A. Blakelock HS FI program has been declining in enrolment since 2016. The past five years has seen the following:

2025 - 61 students *(-67% since 2021)*

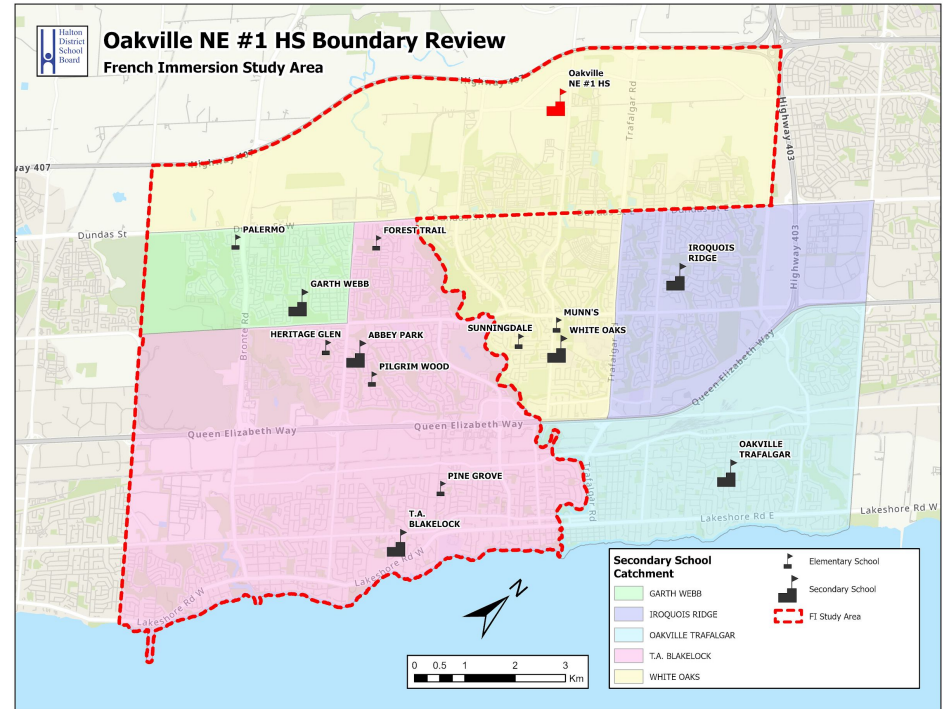
2024 - 93 students

2023 - 131 students

2022 - 149 students

2021 - 187 students

- Projections show that T.A. Blakelock HS FI enrolment will remain stable and lie between 40 to 55 students over the next 10 years.

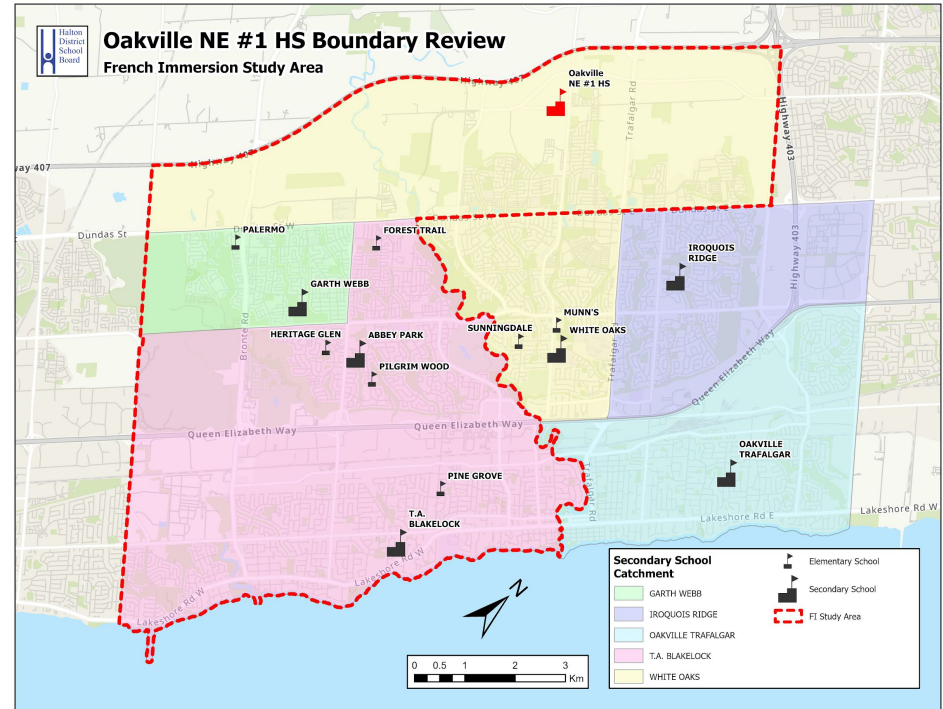


Boundary Review - FI Realignment

FI secondary school realignment (south of Dundas St)

At the Jan 8, 2026 BRSC meeting, Planning Services recommended that the FI program at T.A. Blakelock HS be phased out starting in Sept 2026 and directed to Garth Webb SS. The BRSC is recommending the following:

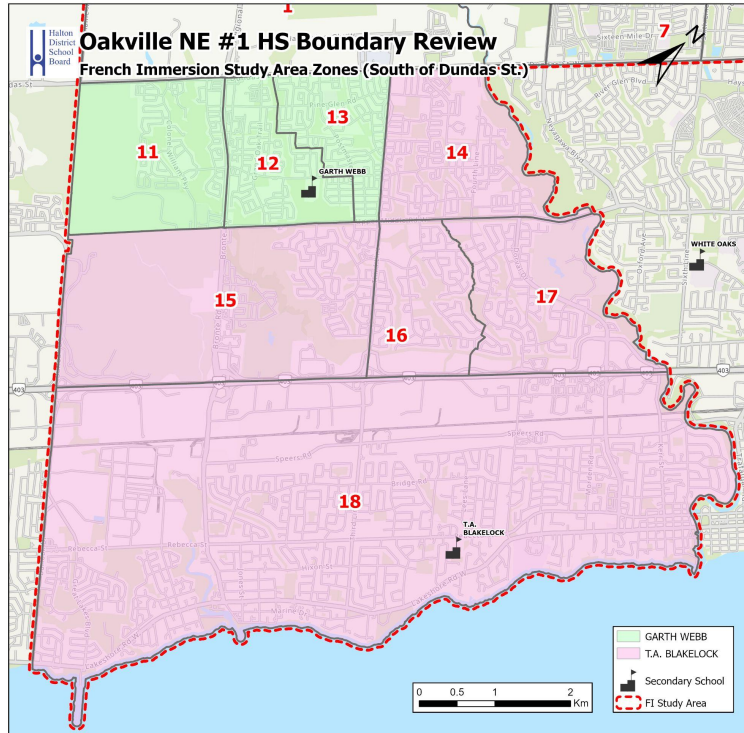
- Current Gr 8 FI students choosing to attend Gr9 FI at T.A. Blakelock HS would instead be directed to Garth Webb SS for Sept 2026.
- Current Gr 9 to Gr 12 FI student at T.A. Blakelocks HS will remain at T.A. Blakelock HS until graduation.
- This recommendation will be part of all options for the Oakville NE #1 HS boundary Options.



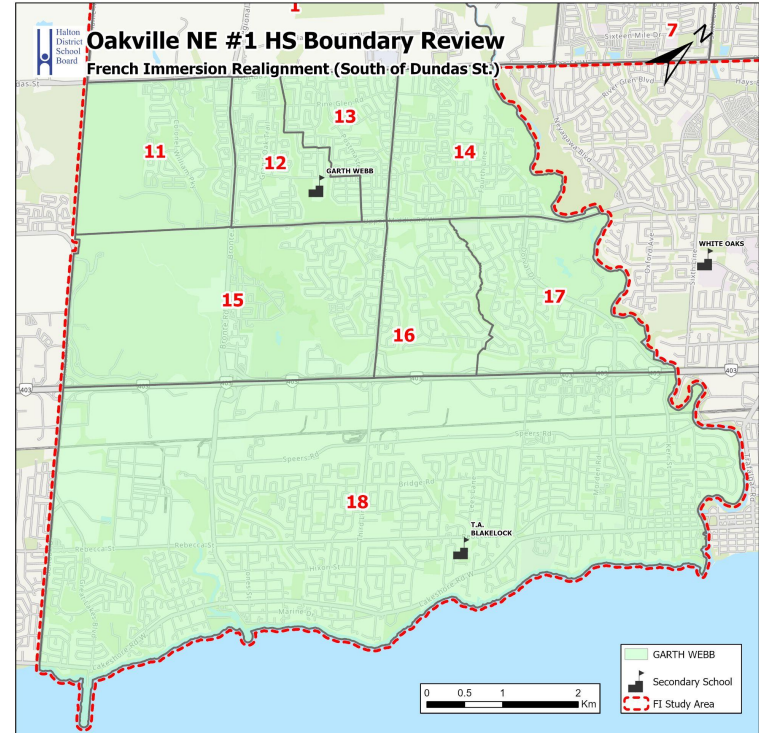

- Significant growth due to new development in North Oakville Secondary Plans (north of Dundas St in Oakville).



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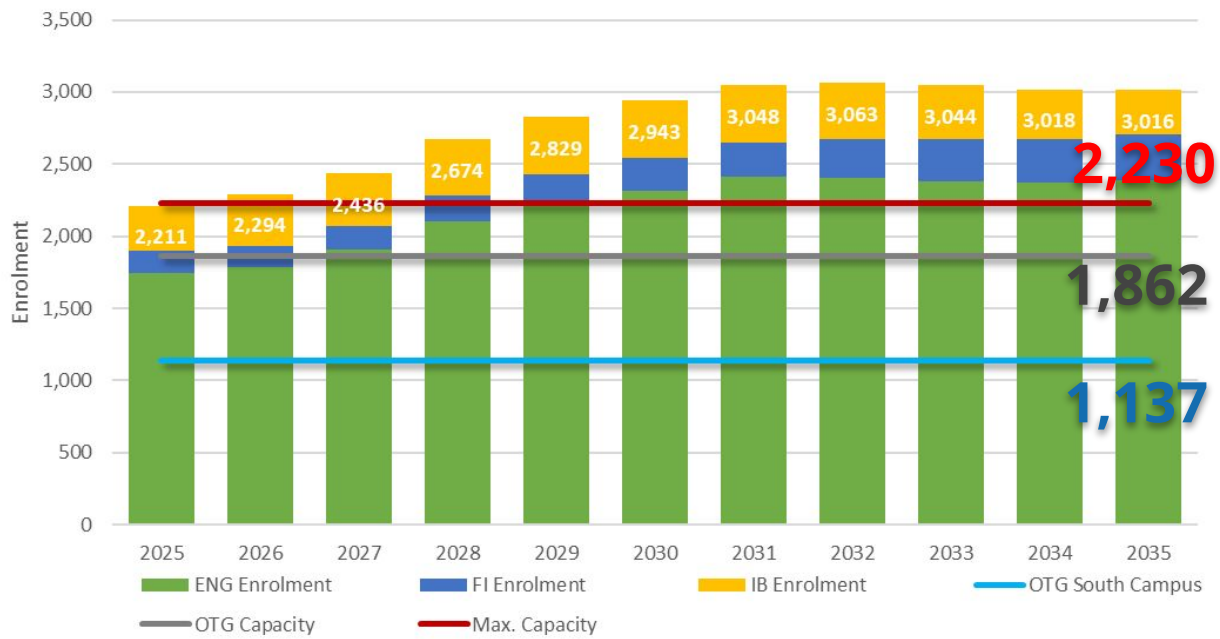

Option 3 - FI Boundary

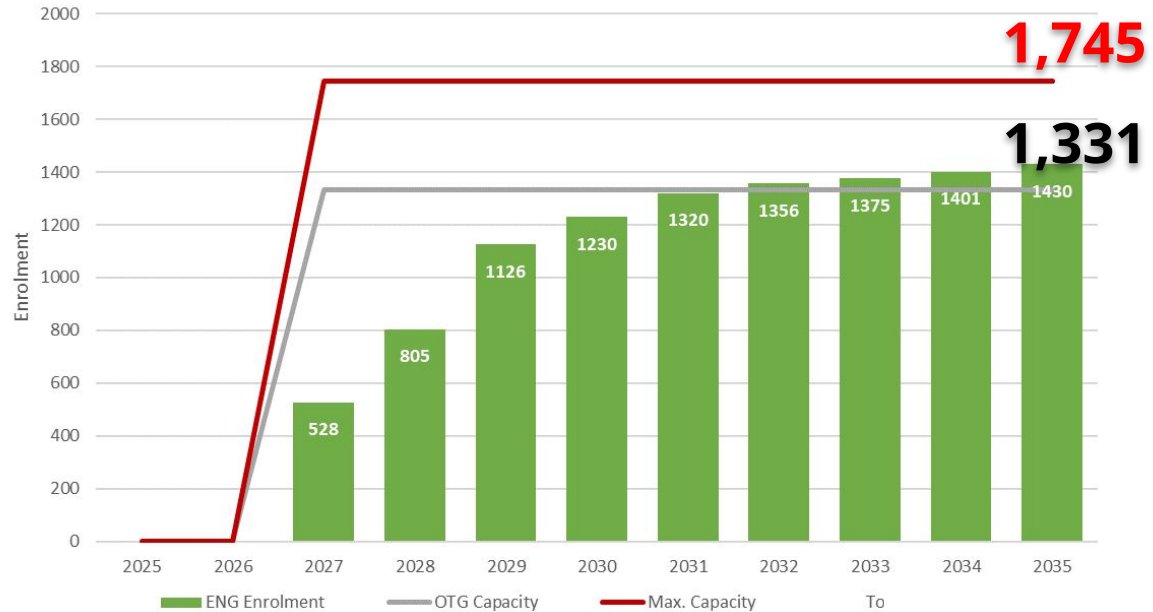

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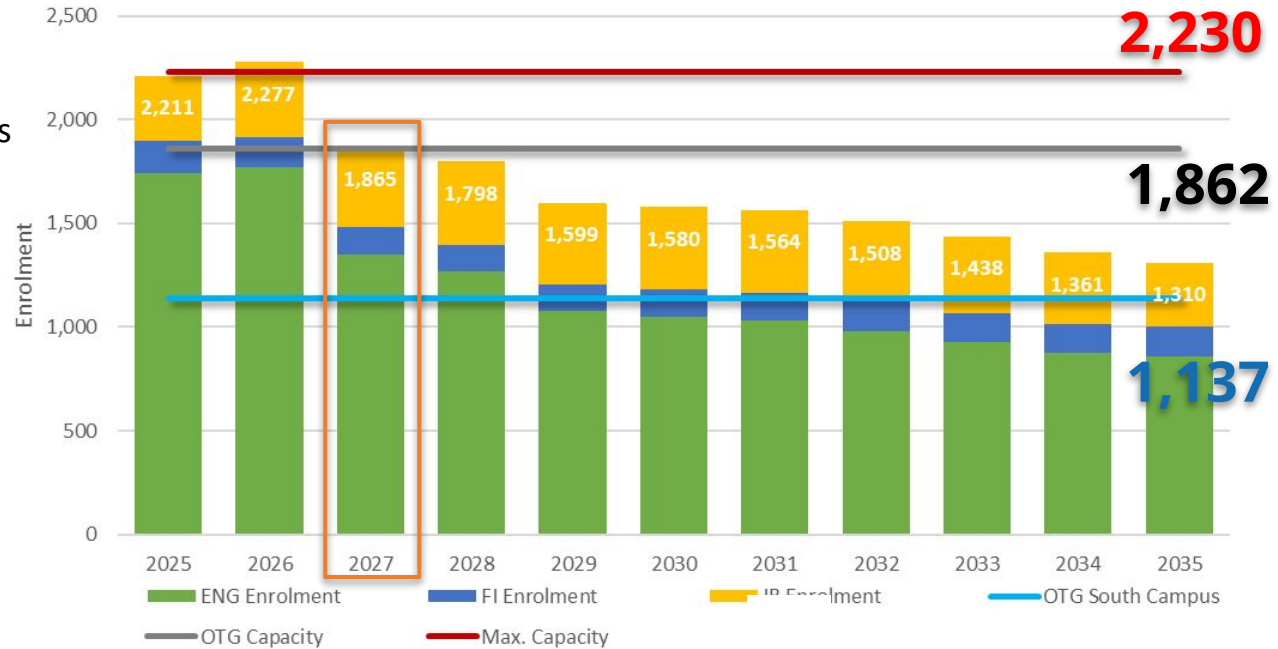

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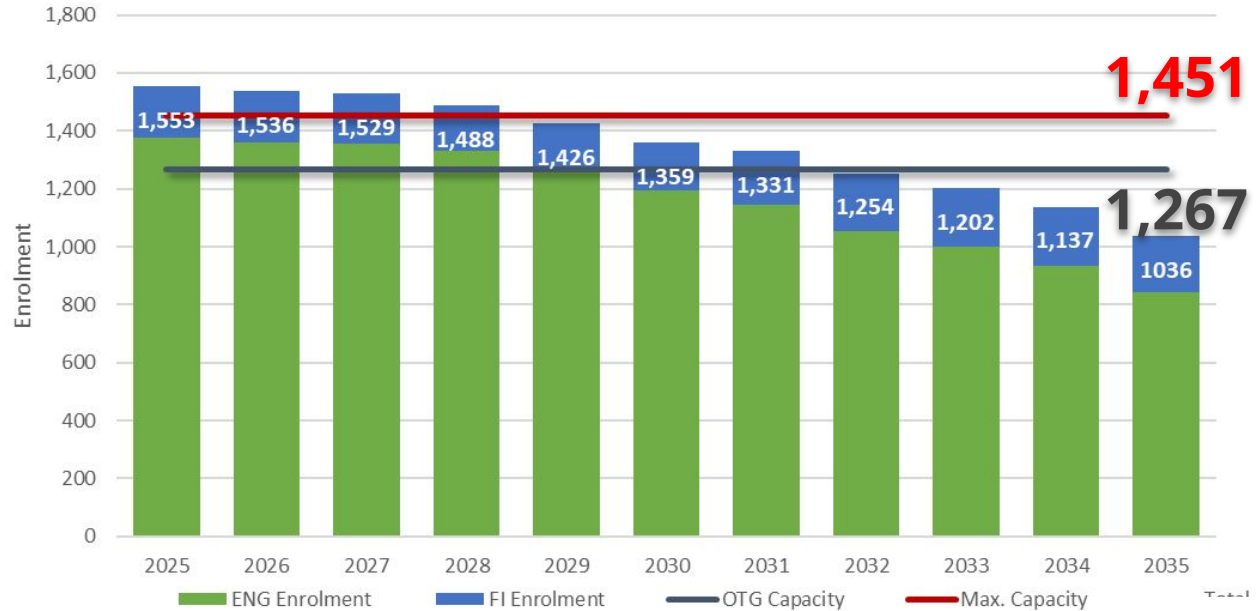
