Why A Boundary Review?

At the September 18, 2019 Board meeting, HDSB Trustees approved a motion to initiate the process to establish a boundary review for the new Milton SS.

Be it resolved that the Halton District School Board direct staff to recommence a school boundary review for the new Milton SW #1 high school, which will include schools in SRA 101, SRA 104 and SRA 105; with an expected completion date of no later than June 2020. (Revised date of November 2020 given COVID challenges.)

Purpose of Boundary Review

- Establish a boundary for the new Milton Secondary School
- Review the current boundaries for Milton District High School, Craig Kielburger Secondary School and Dr. Frank J. Hayden Secondary School

- Proximity to Schools

- Balance of Overall Enrolment
- Long-Term Boundaries
- Transportation
- Fiscally Responsible
- Student Experience
