**SUBJECT: Oakville NE #1 HS Boundary Review - Notice of Approval**

Dear parents/guardians,

We are writing to inform you that Option 3 was approved by the Trustees of the Halton District School Board at the May 5, 2026 Board meeting, as part of the [Oakville NE #1 HS Boundary Review](#). The approval of Option 3 includes the change to the T.A. Blakelock High School French Immersion boundary for the area south of Dundas Street.

#### **How does this impact my family?**

- The implementation of Option 3 will begin with the 2027-2028 school year when Oakville NE #1 HS opens in September 2027.
- Families can learn more about Option 3 through [Board Report 26029](#) and [Appendix D1](#) and [Appendix D2](#). We encourage you to carefully review these documents to understand how the approved recommendation may impact your family.

## Next Steps

- An implementation committee will be formed over the coming weeks. If your child is affected by these changes, you will be contacted in the coming months. At that time, you will receive details about your child's transfer to their newly assigned school for September 2027, along with information about transition resources and support to help your family adjust smoothly.
