Applied? Academic? MyBlueprint has many resources to help you explore all of your options:

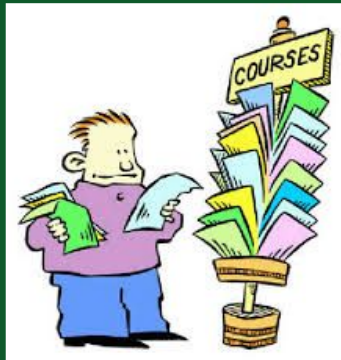


- Complete surveys to be matched with a list of careers that may interest you

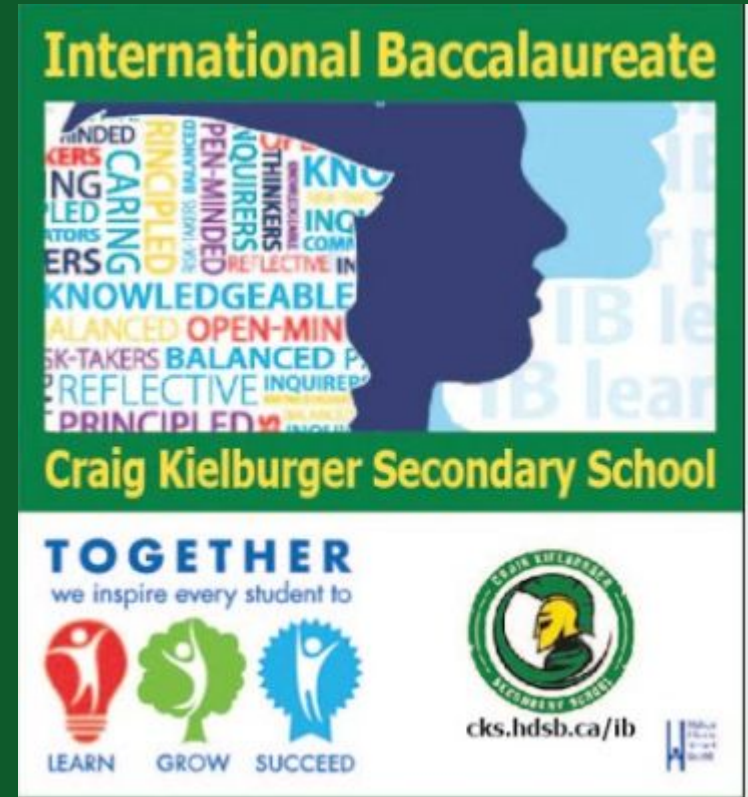

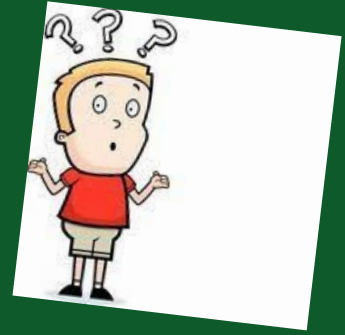

FAQs about Elective Courses...



Can I take an elective course in Gr. 10 if I didn't take it in Gr. 9?

YES!

Do I have to take an elective course in Gr. 10 if I plan on taking it in Gr. 11?

NO! But if it's an ARTS elective course, you need to have the prerequisite in either Gr. 9 OR Gr. 10 in order to take it in Gr. 11

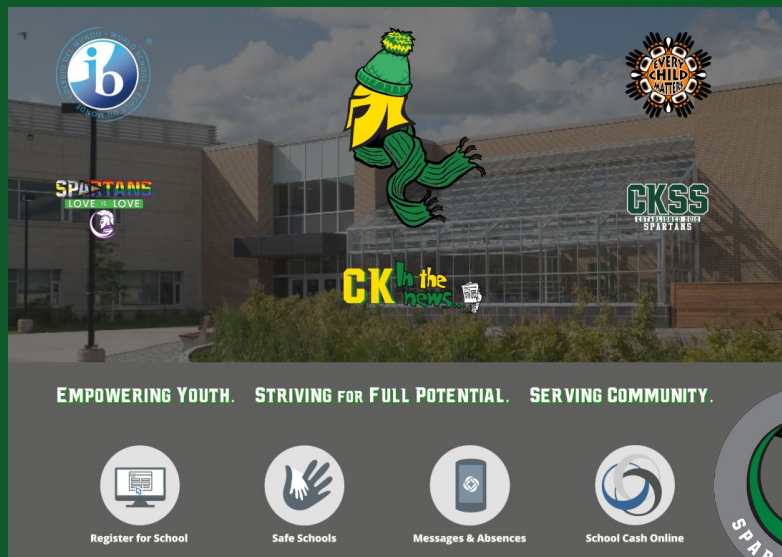

Summer school registration will begin in April.




If you know FOR SURE that you would like to take a summer school course (for example: Civics/ Careers), please:

- 2) Make a note in myBlueprint, letting your Guidance counsellor know that you intend on taking the specific course in the summer.


How to make course selections

1. Go to www.myblueprint.ca/halton
2. Select School Account Log In
3. Login using student's school login and password.
4. Go to High School Plan.
5. Check out Grade 10 courses. Read course descriptions *carefully*.
6. **ADD 9 course selections.**
7. **REVIEW** course selections.
8. After careful consideration, **SUBMIT** choices.



① This course is for students who want to explore topics in audio and video production, graphic design, website design, photography and 3D Animation (Project examples: Magazine covers, Video Shot Compositions, Dream Sequences, Movie Trailers, Poster Design, Music Editing, Photography & Comic Book Page Layout). • Focus on field production, work outside of classroom often • Lots of opportunity for group work and individual projects • Possible field trips to Live TV productions and/or Multi-Media post-secondary programs • Prep for enrolling in an Arts and Culture SHSM program • Provides a better understanding of the media & broadcasting industries • Develop skills that you can use in other classes (such as presentation, creative writing, teamwork, technology, leadership & performance).

Description

Students are required to complete a range of communications technology projects. These may include a combination of desktop Publishing, Web Site Design, Graphics, Audio, Video, Photography, Animation, Computer Assisted Drafting and Multimedia Presentation. A final integrated project and a portfolio form the basis for the summative evaluation.

This course provides students with opportunities to explore different areas of hospitality and tourism with an emphasis on restaurant and food service. Students will learn various culinary techniques, proper food handling and preparation, health and safety standards, the use of tools and equipment and the origins of foods. Whether students are looking to pursue a career as a chef or baker, or just looking to learn some skills to impress their family and friends, this course will provide them with practical knowledge they can use for the rest of their lives.

Description

This course emphasises the scope of the hospitality and tourism industry. Students will study food origins, handling and preparation techniques, health and safety standards and the use of tools and equipment. They will also investigate travel and tourism in Ontario.


