

International Student Program Informed Consent

- 1. Participation in the HDSB International Student Program involves certain elements of risk. Loss or injury may result during periods of travel and study. The risk of injuries results from the nature of participating in the program and can occur without any fault of either the participant, the school board, its employees/agents, or the contracted service provider. By choosing to take part in the program you are accepting the risk that your child, or yourself, as student at the Age of Majority, may be injured. By choosing to have your child, or yourself, as student at the Age of Majority, participate in the program, you understand that you bear the responsibility for any loss or injury that may occur.
- 2. If an applicant becomes ill or incapacitated, the HDSB may take such action as it considers necessary, including securing medical treatment and transporting the applicant home at his/her own expense.
- 3. We understand that the applicant's participation in the program may be terminated at the discretion of the Superintendent of Education of the HDSB without any refund of tuition fee, and that the applicant may be sent home at his/her own expense if he/she does not adhere to the school or HDSB rules, standards and instructions as set forth in the school's agenda, handbook and the Participation Agreement of the International Student Program. This agreement with the HDSB cannot be modified or interpreted except in writing by the Superintendent.
- 4. The student and the parent warrant that the student applicant has no history of criminal behaviour. Any disputes of a legal nature must be resolved through the courts of Ontario.
- 5. We understand that placement in a school is subject to availability of space. The HDSB reserves the right to determine final school and grade placement.
- 6. We fully understand the refund policy of the HDSB. We understand that the HDSB shall not be held liable for losses or expenses as a result of the Board being unable to provide education owing to labour disputes or other unforeseen circumstances.
- 7. The medical insurance coverage provided to the Halton District School Board's international students is subject to limitations and exclusions. Students who require care for unstable or chronic/ongoing conditions will have to pay for medical treatments directly.

8. School tuition fees are subject to change at any time without notice.
