DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION – ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES and ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REVIEW

OBJECTIVE

The Halton District School Board (the "Board") is committed to a model of operational leadership which is consistent with *the Education Act*, Ministry of Education direction, and the principles of good governance, as more particularly described in the Board's *Operational Leadership Procedure*.

The Board of Trustees (the "BoT") will annually evaluate the performance of the Director of Education (the "Director") in meeting their duties under *the Act.*

LEGAL FRAMEWORK

The Board derives its authority from the *Education Act*¹ and the Regulations made under the Act. The *Education Act* provides that the Director is the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Educational Officer, and Secretary to the BoT.²

The Act states: "The chief executive officer of a board shall, within policies established by the board, develop and maintain an effective organization and the programs required to implement such policies."³

It is the responsibility of the Director to provide operational leadership in a manner that effectively implements the Board's multi-year plan, policies, procedures and practices for student achievement and well-being.⁴

The Education Act includes the BoT duty to annually evaluate the performance of the Director.⁵
