### 1. Objective

The Halton District School Board (HDSB) is committed to involving students by providing opportunities for student voice and ensuring that student perspectives are considered in the decisions made by the Board through the annual appointment of two Student Trustees.

## 2. Policy Statement

- 2.1. The Board shall have at least two but not more than three Student Trustees.<sup>1</sup>
- 2.2. Student Trustees must be entering or enrolled full-time in the senior division (Grade 11 or 12) of a secondary school of the Board, or be an exceptional pupil in a special education program for whom the Board has reduced the length of the program under subsection 3 (3) of Regulation 298.<sup>2</sup>
- 2.3. The term of office of Student Trustees starts on August 1 of the year in which they are elected and ends on July 31 of the following year.
