



Construction Update

Building a Better School - May 2019

We are excited to share an update for M.M. Robinson High School's continued renovations to provide the necessary facility enhancements and upgrades related to the addition of new programs.

Status of Construction

The renovation/new construction is organized into two phases. Phase 1 work took place during the Summer 2018. Phase 2 is currently underway and we anticipate the general contractor and construction personnel to be on site until December 2019.

Phase 1 (Completed Summer 2018):

- New Community Pathway Program learning spaces
- New outdoor learning space
- Additional student washrooms
- Rebranding of the Lester B. Pearson Theatre
- Reconfiguration of Technical Education spaces
- Refreshed interior spaces (e.g., foyer, hallways, lockers, etc.)
- Exterior building enhancements (e.g., siding, roofing, asphalt, etc.)

Phase 2 (Beginning May 2019):

- New cafeteria, including a renovated food school
- New 3 storey, 6 classroom addition

Safety during construction

You may have already noticed storage and disposal bins on site. New equipment will be arriving on a regular basis and additional fencing will be used to secure the site as work progresses. There may be disruptions from time to time at school where classrooms are moved, hallways closed or parking areas reduced.

Due to the reduced laneway in the front of the school, please drop off and/or pick up students from "Door 5". This is located in the shared parking lot with the Halton District School Board's J.W. Singleton Centre, on the east side of the school.
