Aldershot High School - French Immersion Boundary Notification

At the Jan. 22, 2020 Board meeting, Trustees of the Halton District School Board passed the below motion to initiate a process to review the boundary for the French Immersion program at Aldershot High School. This boundary review is only for the secondary school program (French Immersion Grade 9-12). A Boundary Review Steering Committee will review options for students entering French Immersion for Grade 9 effective September 2020.

The following is the motion passed at the Jan. 22, 2020 Board of Trustees meeting:

RECOMMENDATION:

Be it resolved that the Halton District School Board directs staff to undertake a school boundary review for the French Immersion program at Aldershot High School; with an expected completion date by February 2020.

The Boundary Review Steering Committee will include Trustee Leah Reynolds (Burlington Wards 1 and 2), Trustee Tanya Rocha (Oakville Wards 3 and 6), Superintendents of Education Gord Truffen, Terri Blackwell and Julie Hunt Gibbons and Planning Department Staff. The boundary review process is expected to be completed no later than February 2020 with boundary changes to be implemented for September 2020.
