Themes that came out of submitted Livestream Questions on February 2, 2023

Questions Regarding the process including

- The purpose of the review to relieve enrolment pressure at Glenview PS.
- Next steps
 - Reviewing feedback with BRC
 - BRSC presenting a Preferred option to the Director and Senior Team
 - A Final option to be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval
- Delegation process

Before and Aftercare availability for students being moved.

- The YMCA is aware of the boundary change.
- The YMCA will be sending a memo to Glenview before and aftercare school families to determine how many families are enrollment at Glenview PS will need care at Maplehurst PS

Themes that came out of submitted Livestream Questions on February 2, 2023

Support for students who would be switching schools

Questions regarding student mental health and well-being, in context with the pandemic and virtual learning

- As part of the the <u>School Boundary Review Administrative Procedure</u>, an Integration Committee will plan for and implement the positive integration of students and staff affected by the boundary decision and relocation into their new school environment. The Family of Schools Superintendent of Education would act as the Chair of the Integration Committee.
- Some details to consider to administer integration:
 - Team and community building activities
 - Grouping of students that moved from Glenview PS into the same class or have buddy requests
 - Teacher and school administrator involvement

Themes that came out of submitted Livestream Questions on February 2, 2023

Out of Area Transfers ("Optional Attendance")

Questions regarding the ability to remain at Glenview PS if they are impacted by the new boundary.

- The Board encourages students to attend their designated school but there is a process that can be followed.
- <u>Out of Area Transfer</u> requests is the process where student can apply to attend a school other than the school designated for their area of residence.
- One of the requirements that would allow a student to attend a school that is not their designated school is if there is enough space at the school to accommodate them
 - The purpose of this study is to alleviate accommodation pressures at Glenview PS so Out of Area Transfer requests will not be fulfilled by this school.
 - As for Maplehurst PS, this will be reviewed on a case by case basis subject to availability of space.

Themes that came out of submitted Livestream Questions on February 2, 2023

Legacy Exemption ("Grandfathering/Grandparenting")

Questions regarding who is eligible for legacy exemption if impacted by boundary changes

- All the Options (1 to 13) presented to date have assumed the following:
 - September 2023 implementation of the new boundaries
 - Current Grade 5 English students will not be impacted, they will remain at their current school for Grade 6.
- Consideration may be given to extending the exemption to beyond current Grade 5 students.

- Zones A and B moving
- Zone E divisions





- <2% from each of Zones J, and K.




Average Rating of All Criteria for Option 3:

- Background shading shows average of all responses in the zone.




Average Rating of All Criteria for Option 10:

- Background shading shows average of all responses in the zone.




Average Rating of All Criteria for Option 11:

- Background shading shows average of all responses in the zone.









Grades of Children:








How Well Does Option 10 Meet The Criteria



How Well Does Option 3, 10 & 11 Meet The Criteria



Written Feedback

Common themes in the feedback (from most commented to least):

- 1. Distance to home school/walkability to the school.
 - a. Availability to allow students to bike to the school.
- 2. Impact of Covid-19 and Mental Health of students changing schools/being removed from established friendships.
- 3. Issues with the phasing of students.
 - a. Legacy exemptions.
 - b. Excluding current students from moving.
 - c. Excluding older/established neighbourhoods from being moved.
- 4. Concern over preferential treatment of Zone E.
- 5. Concerns over crossing Plains Road and other Major Roadways.
- 6. Concern over school congestion during entry and dismissal.
- 7. Minimize the number of portables on each site.
- 8. Lack of data available for the community to study and develop options.

Feedback Conclusion:


- All options had an average rating of 3 or more.
- Overwhelming Majority of responses were from Glenview PS.
- Location of parent respondents versus the impacts of each option did result in a bias in the feedback. When evaluating the criteria, some options present a better solution to individual criteria than others but were rated lower, regardless of how successful it was in meeting that criteria:
 - Criteria ranking questions resulted in a "do you like this option" rather than "how well does it fit each criteria"
 - Example would be certain responses giving a 1 out of 5 to "Balance of enrolment", when each option are comparable in distribution.
- A sizeable portion of the written feedback responses are whether or not the family is impacted by the option.
- Feedback was primarily from zones F, C, E, and H


English Program Boundary




Status Quo - Transportation

Option Summary:

- Glenview PS: Approximately 250 students eligible for transportation.
- 2. Glenview PS: Three (3) large bus and three (3) minibus routes.
- Maplehurst PS: Approximately 220 students eligible for transportation.
- 4. Maplehurst PS: Six (6) large bus and two (2) minibus routes.
- 5. Two (2) large bus and two (2) minibus routes are combined between the schools.





Criteria to Evaluate Options

Criteria to review options include but no limited to:


Viability of Programs: Can programs be successfully maintained at the school?	Proximity to schools: Are safe walk-to opportunities maximized?
Stable Long Term Boundaries: Is there long term stability and avoid a another boundary change in the short term?	Balance of Enrolments: Is access to programs, resources, extra curricular opportunities being maximized? Can over/under utilization be avoided?
Portable and Portapaks: Is the use of portable classroom minimized?	Transportation: Is this option cost effective for transportation?
Fiscal Responsibility: Does this option avoid unnecessary costs?	Student Experience: Does this option reduce the number of moves? Are cohorts kept together?

Option 3 - Boundaries

Option Summary:

- 1. Students south of Plains Rd to remain at Glenview PS.
- 2. Students north of Plains Rd and west of Waterdown Rd to remain at Glenview PS
- Maplehurst PS boundary extended west to Waterdown Rd
- 4. Future development in Aldershot Corners to attend Maplehurst PS
- 5. Phased transition to Maplehurst PS starting with students in grade K-5
- 6. Approximately 75 students to be redirected to Maplehurst PS.




Option 3 - Transportation

Option Summary:

- Small number of students (<10) become eligible for transportation.
- 2. Reduction of two (2) minibus routes and one (1) large bus route at Glenview PS.
- 3. New students to be absorbed into existing Maplehurst PS bus routes.





Option Summary:

- 1. Areas north of Hwy 403 to attend Maplehurst.
- 2. Areas north of Masonry and north of Plains Rd between Cooke Blvd and Waterdown Rd to attend Maplehurst PS
- 3. Zone Ea to attend Maplehurst PS. Zone Eb to attend Glenview PS.
- 4. Future development in Aldershot Corners to attend Maplehurst PS
- 5. Approximately 80 students to be redirected to Maplehurst PS.



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

- Will receive students from Glenview PS in grades K-5 effective September 2023.


