Option Development

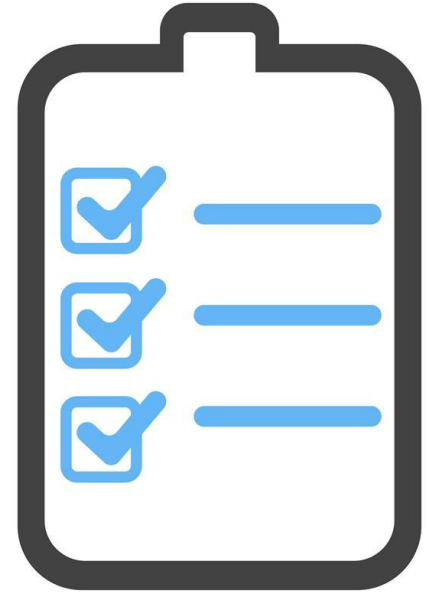
After the last BRC meeting (Nov 2, 2023) it was determined that Option 5 was the preferred option to move forward with. There were two main issues that came out of the discussion around Option 5:

1. Zone N - should this zone remain in Dr. David R. Williams ENG boundary?
2. Post's Corners boundary - which Zones should remain within this school's boundary (Zones AE, AH, AI, AJ)?

Options were developed as follow:

1. Options 5 and 6 (2 options) - addresses Zone N ([comparison summary](#))
2. Options X1 to X5 (5 options) - addresses Post's Corners/River Oaks boundaries (south of Dundas Street) ([comparison summary](#))

Note that Options 6, X1 to X5 are all based off of Option 5

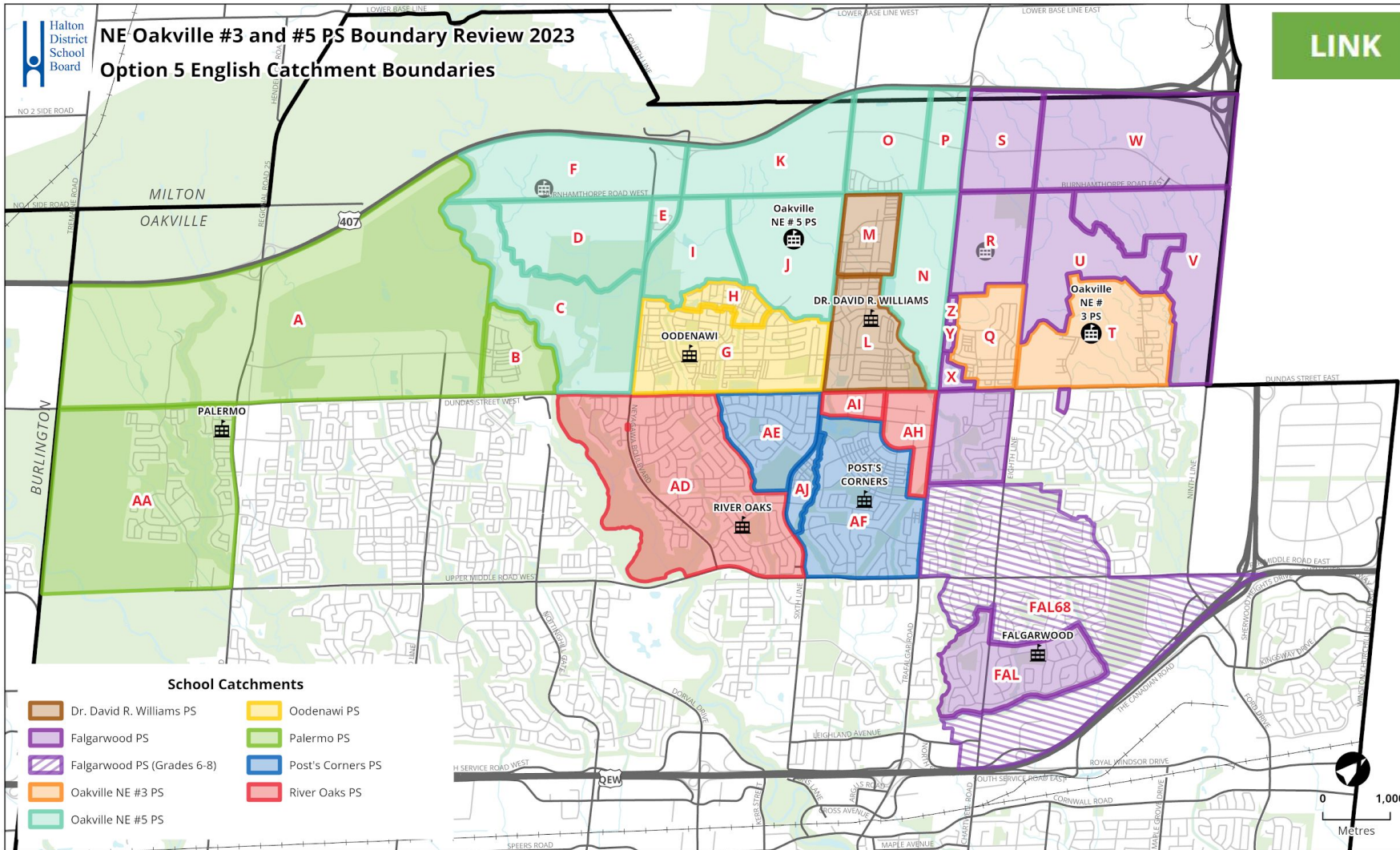

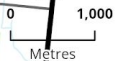

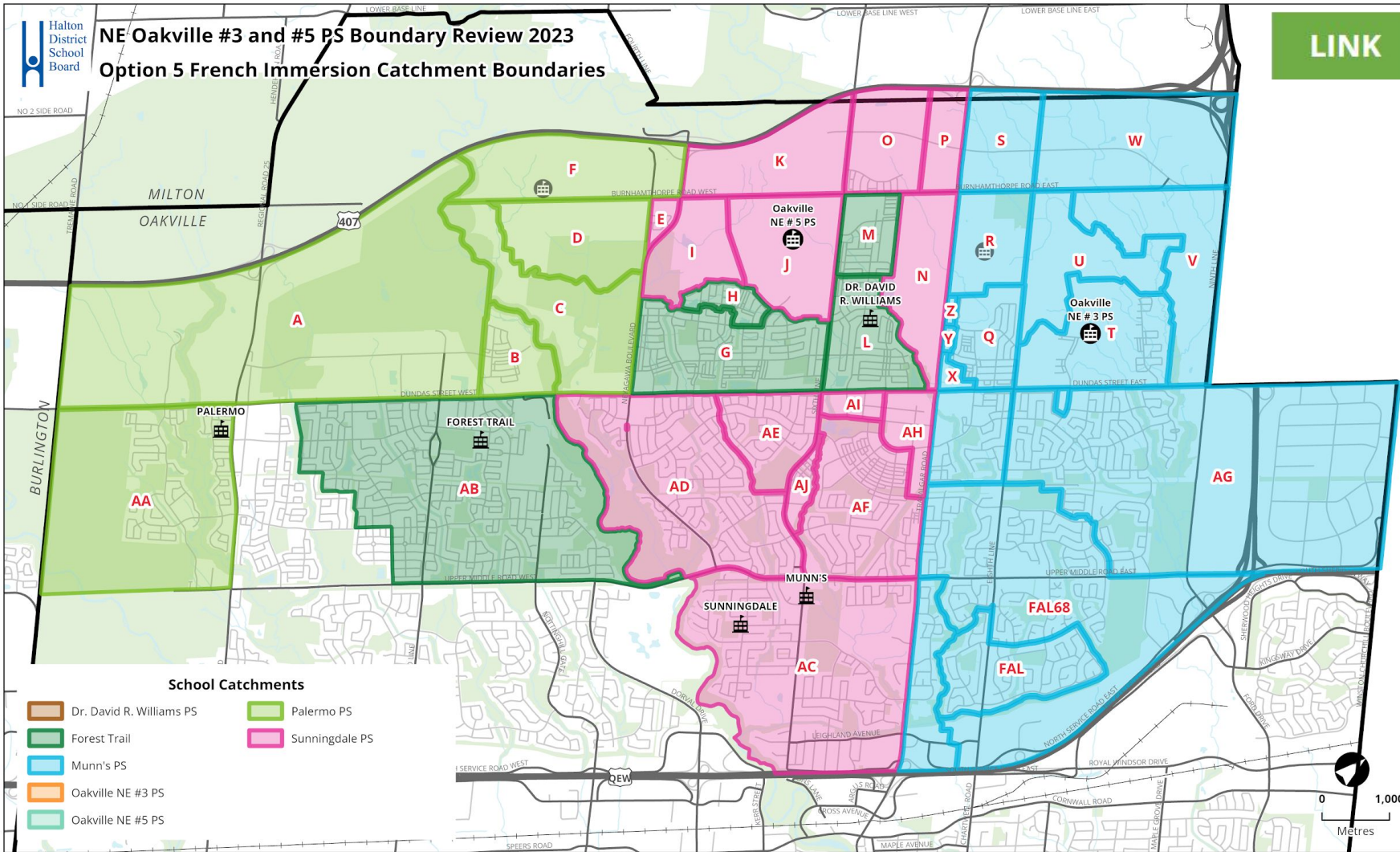


OPT 5 - FI Boundary



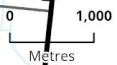

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Option 5 Summary

Update to Option 5:

- Starting in Sept 2024, Grade 2-5 FI students directed to Forest Trail, Grade 6-8 FI remains at Dr. David R. Williams (legacy exemption); school becomes a single track ENG school by the 2027/28 school year
- Starting in Sept 2024, Zone ENG-H JK-5 ENG students directed to Oodenawi, Grade 6-8 ENG remains at Dr. David R. Williams (legacy exemption)
- Starting in Sept 2025 (opening of Oakville NE #3), Zones ENG-AI and AH JK-5 ENG students directed to River Oaks, Grade 6-8 ENG remains at Post's Corners (legacy exemption)

Staff Considerations and Flags:

- No schools exceed Max Capacity before 2031
- Stable boundaries long-term, until new schools open
- Very good distribution of enrolment
- Existing Dr. David R. Williams and Oodenawi FI cohorts will all move together to one new school facility
- Increased need for transportation in Zones AI and AH
- Most High Density residential development moving to another facility
- Creates a split Gr8 cohort for Forest Trail
- Opportunity for more legacy exemptions

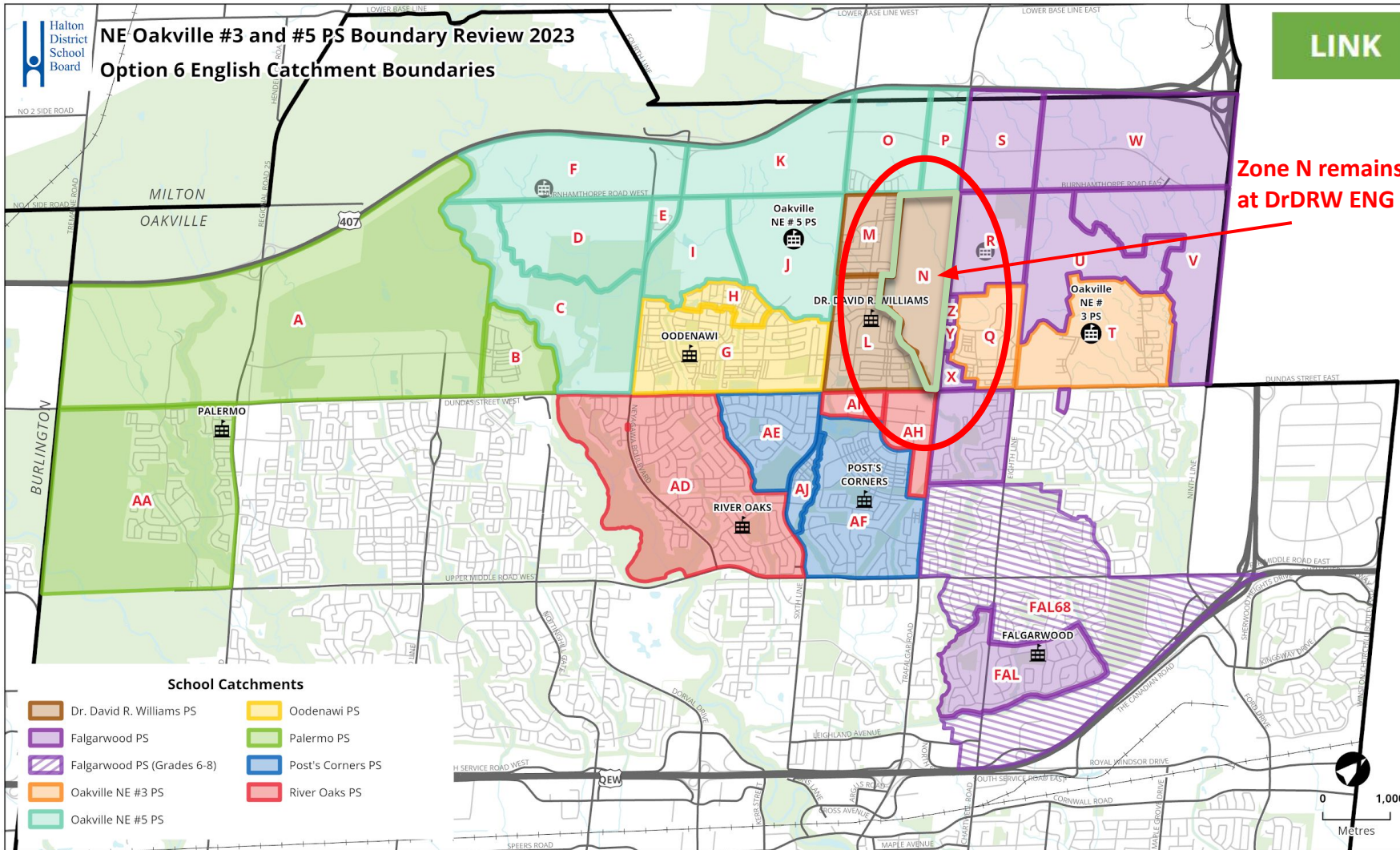

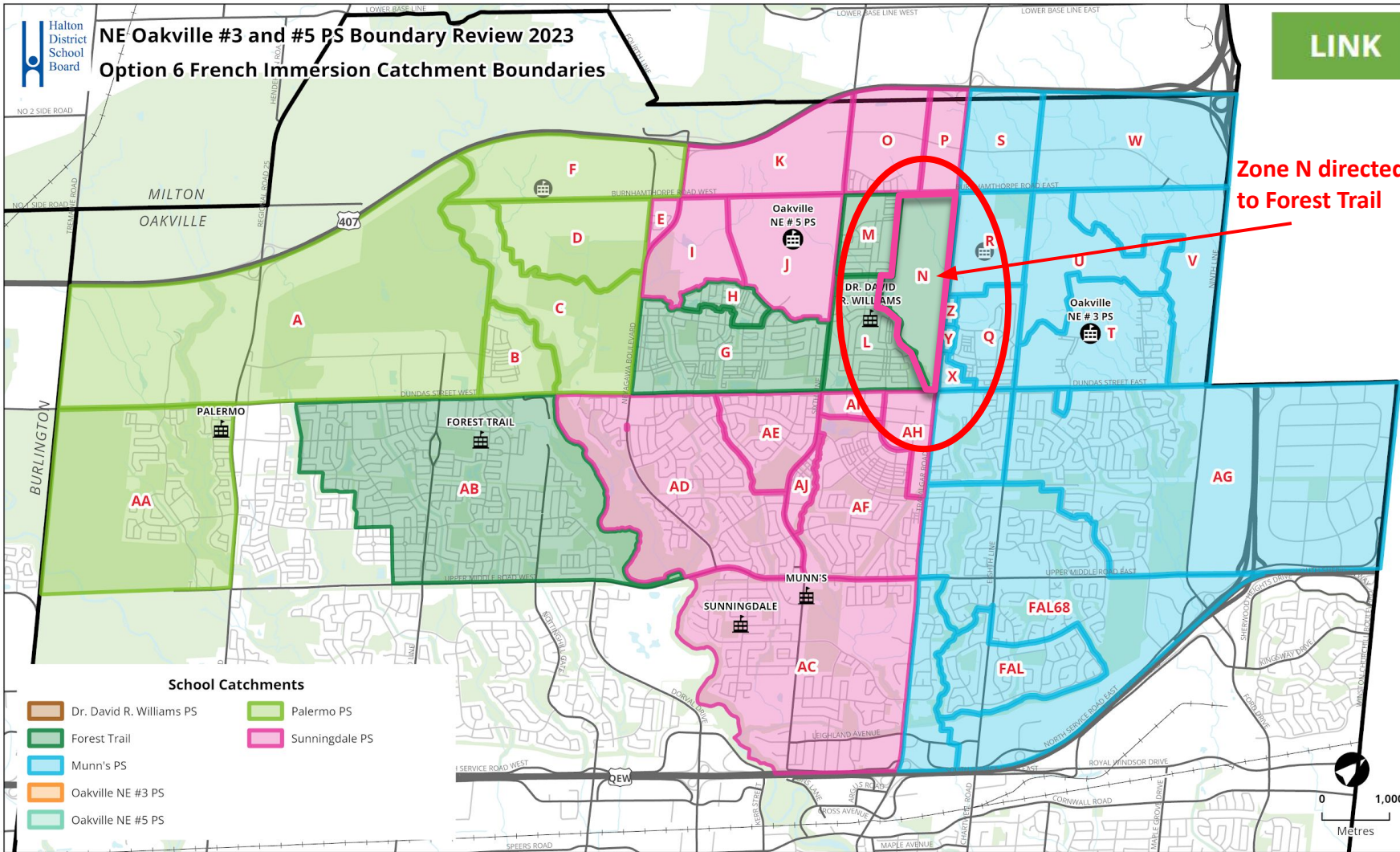


OPT 6 - FI Boundary

Modification to Option 5:

- Move Zone ENG-N from Oakville NE #5 to Dr. David R. Williams
- Move Zones FI-N from Sunningdale to Forest Trail

Staff Considerations and Flags:

- Keeps a portion of Zone N within walking distance to Dr. David R. Williams once new residential development and road network is built out
- Keeps Dr. David R. Williams FI cohort together to Forest Trail
- Oakville NE #5 reaches Max Capacity by 2033
- Dr. David R. Williams remains under Max Capacity



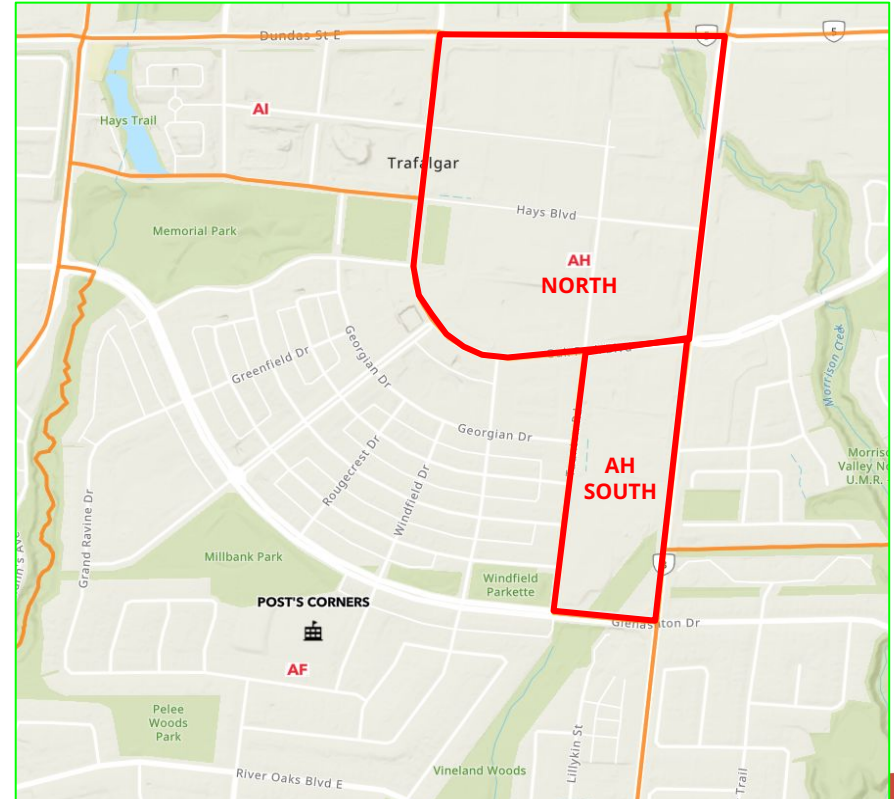

Update to Option 5:

- Starting Sept 2025, Zones AI and AH JK-5 ENG students move to River Oaks; Grade 6-8 ENG remain at Post's Corners (legacy exemption)

Staff Considerations and Flags:

- Increase need for transportation for Zones AH and AI to River Oaks
- Decrease in portables from 12 to 5 at Post's Corners by 2025; no portables projected for River Oaks
