At the February 1, 2017 meeting of the Board, Trustees deliberated on the redirection of students in the Alton West 510-03/03 subdivision area bounded by Dundas Street to the south, Walkers Line to the east and Highway 407 to the north and west. As a result, Trustees approved motion 17008, identifying elementary and secondary schools for students residing in this area effective September, 2017 as follows:
