

Oakville NE #2 ps Boundary Review

Further detailed notes on scenarios 11a, 14a, 14b, and 15 presented at January 10, 2019 public meeting

General Notes

- At the start of the boundary review (October 2018), it was assumed that Oakville NE #2 ps would open in 2019/2020 school year; as the review progressed and more information regarding provincial funding was updated it was determined that the school would not be able to be constructed in time for a 2019/2020 school year opening and most likely be opening for Sept 2020
- Projections for these four scenarios presented to the public assumes September 2020 implementation and current boundaries will remain for 2019/2020 school year
 - Oakville NE #2 ps opens September 2020, initial assumption is that Oakville NE #2 ps will open as JK-7 ENG and 2-7 FI school (if scenario has Oakville NE #2 ps offering a FI program), unless otherwise described in scenario
 - Grade 8 students (current grade 6 students) do not move in a boundary change and remain at their current school; younger siblings can remain until the older sibling graduates where it is assumed that the younger sibling will move to their new home school
- Currently, Oodenawi PS is closed to new ENG and FI registrations (within 2018/2019 ENG and FI boundaries)
 - New registrations within the current Oodenawi ENG and FI boundaries will be directed to Palermo PS for the remainder of the 2018/2019 school year and for the 2019/2020 school year
 - Students who are attending Palermo PS (within the current Oodenawi PS boundaries) are assumed to be Oodenawi PS students and have been included in Oodenawi's projections
 - These students that are within the current Oodenawi PS ENG and FI boundaries will move from Palermo PS once Oakville NE #2 ps opens and new boundaries are implemented
- Currently, River Oaks PS is closed to new ENG registrations for 2019/2020 school year and are direct to Falgarwood PS
- As of February 1, 2019, River Oaks PS will be closed to new 2018/2019 registrations north of Dundas but remain open to new registrations south of Dundas within the River Oaks PS boundary
- To Be Determined area (TBD) created to delay implementation of school boundaries for these new developments; housing development projected to begin 2021
 - There is no impact on existing students on rural residential properties in TBD area
- In the word descriptions on impact on schools in the scenarios, geographical references will be identified on ENG and FI maps (ie. Areas 1, 2, 3, etc.)
- There are approximately 267 ENG and FI students north of Dundas that have been projected and will be temporarily be holding at Palermo PS and Falgarwood PS for the remainder of the 2018/2019 school year and for the 2019/2020 school year; these are students that live north of Dundas and live within the Oodenawi PS ENG and FI boundaries or within the River Oaks PS ENG boundary (north of Dundas), these students area placed back in the studies projection numbers starting in 2020/2021 once Oakville NE #2 ps opens

Oakville NE #2 ps (single track ENG school, FI students in this area directed to Sunningdale PS)

- In 2020/2021, school opens as JK-7 ENG school with grade 8 ENG added 2021/2022

Munn's PS

- **AREA 3 - ENG students in the area north of Dundas between Sixth Line and Trafalgar**
 - In 2020/2021 JK-7 ENG students at River Oaks PS move from River Oaks PS and attend Oakville NE #2 ps; grade 8 ENG students stay at River Oaks PS with their younger siblings; younger siblings move to Oakville NE #2 ps once their grade 8 sibling graduates from River Oaks PS
- **AREA 4 - ENG students in the area south of Burnhamthorpe between Fourth Line and Neyagawa**
 - In 2020/2021 JK-7 ENG students at Oodenawi PS move from Oodenawi PS and attend River Oaks PS; grade 8 ENG students stay at Oodenawi PS with their younger siblings; younger siblings move to River Oaks PS once their grade 8 sibling graduates from Oodenawi PS
- **AREAS 2 and 3 - FI students in the area north of Dundas/North Park between Neyagawa/Preserve and Trafalgar**
 - In 2020/2021 grade 7 to 8 FI students at Oodenawi PS stay at Oodenawi PS with their younger siblings; younger siblings move to Sunningdale PS once their grade 7 to 8 older sibling graduates from Oodenawi PS; grade 2 to 6 FI students with no grade 7 to 8 FI sibling will move from Oodenawi PS and attend Sunningdale PS; all new grade 2 to 8 FI registrations in this area will be directed to Sunningdale PS

- **AREA 4 - FI students in the area south of Burnhamthorpe between Fourth Line and Neyagawa**
 - In 2020/2021 grade 7 to 8 FI students at Oodenawi PS stay at Oodenawi PS with their younger siblings; younger siblings move to Sunningdale PS once their grade 7 to 8 older sibling graduates from Oodenawi PS and attend Sunningdale PS; all new grade 2 to 8 FI registrations in this area will be directed to Sunningdale PS
- **AREA 5 - FI students in the area south of Dundas to River Glen between Sixteen Mile Creek and Munn's Creek**
 - In 2020/2021 grade 7 to 8 FI students at Oodenawi PS (the current Grade 5 and 6 FI in 2018/2019 school year) stay at Oodenawi PS with their younger siblings; younger siblings move to Sunningdale PS once their grade 7 to 8 older sibling graduates from Oodenawi PS; grade 2 to 6 FI students with no grade 7 to 8 FI sibling will move from Oodenawi PS and attend Sunningdale PS; all new grade 2 to 8 FI registrations in this area will be directed to Sunningdale PS

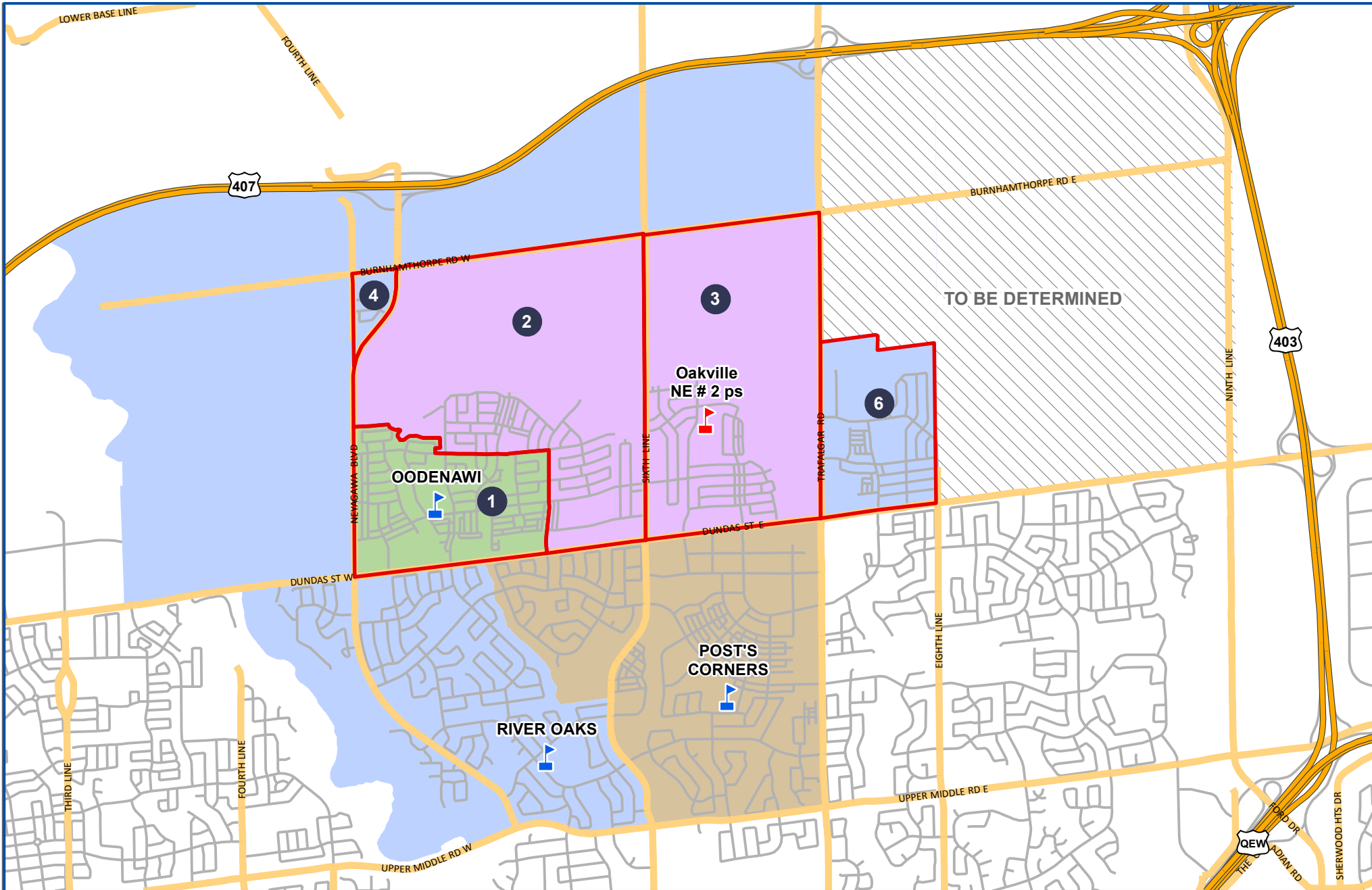

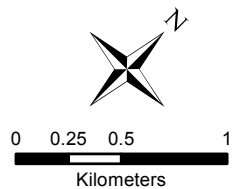

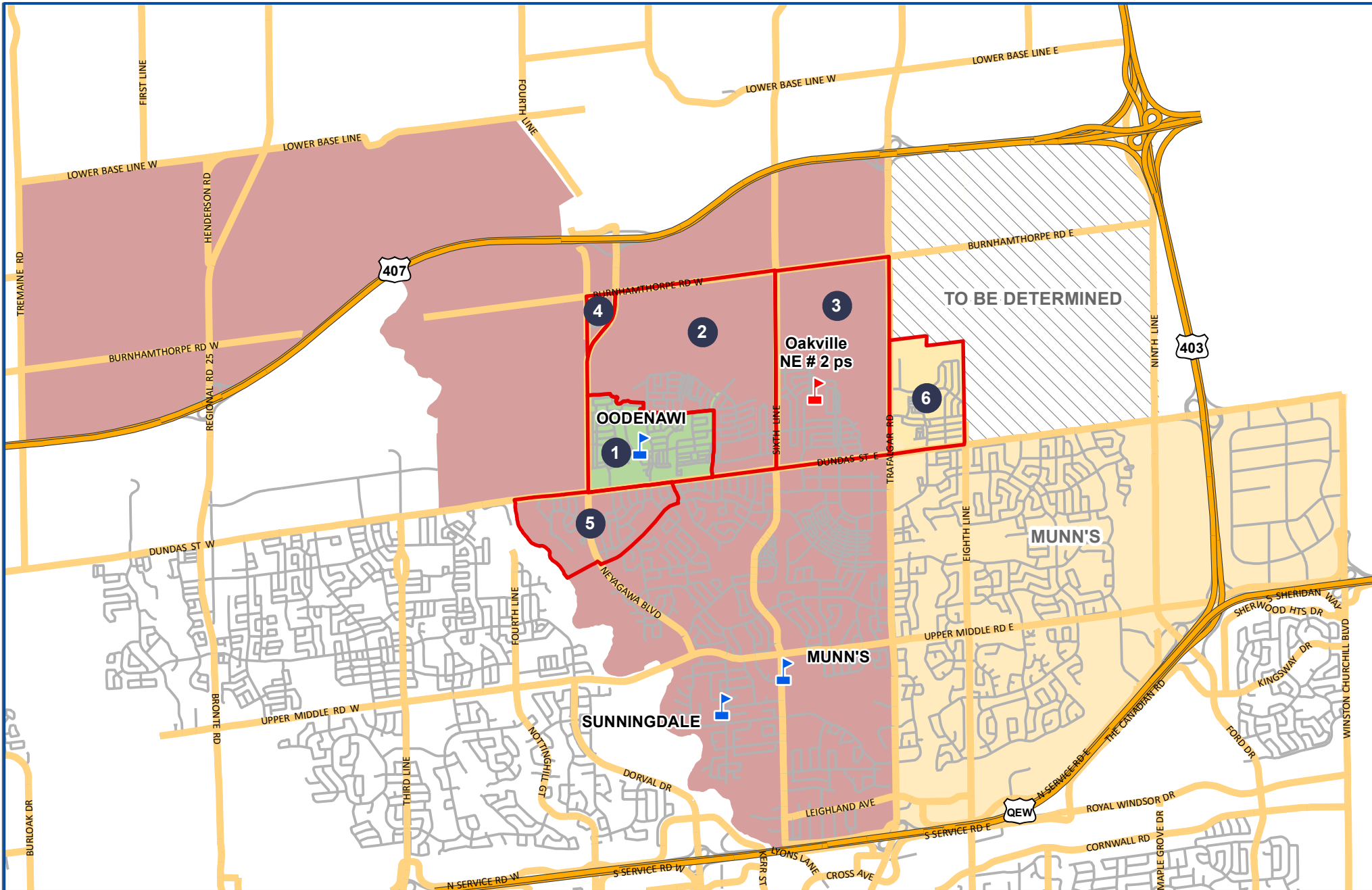
Scenario 11 a English Program Boundary



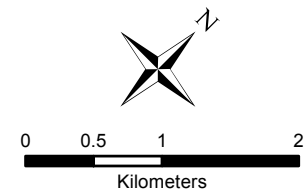

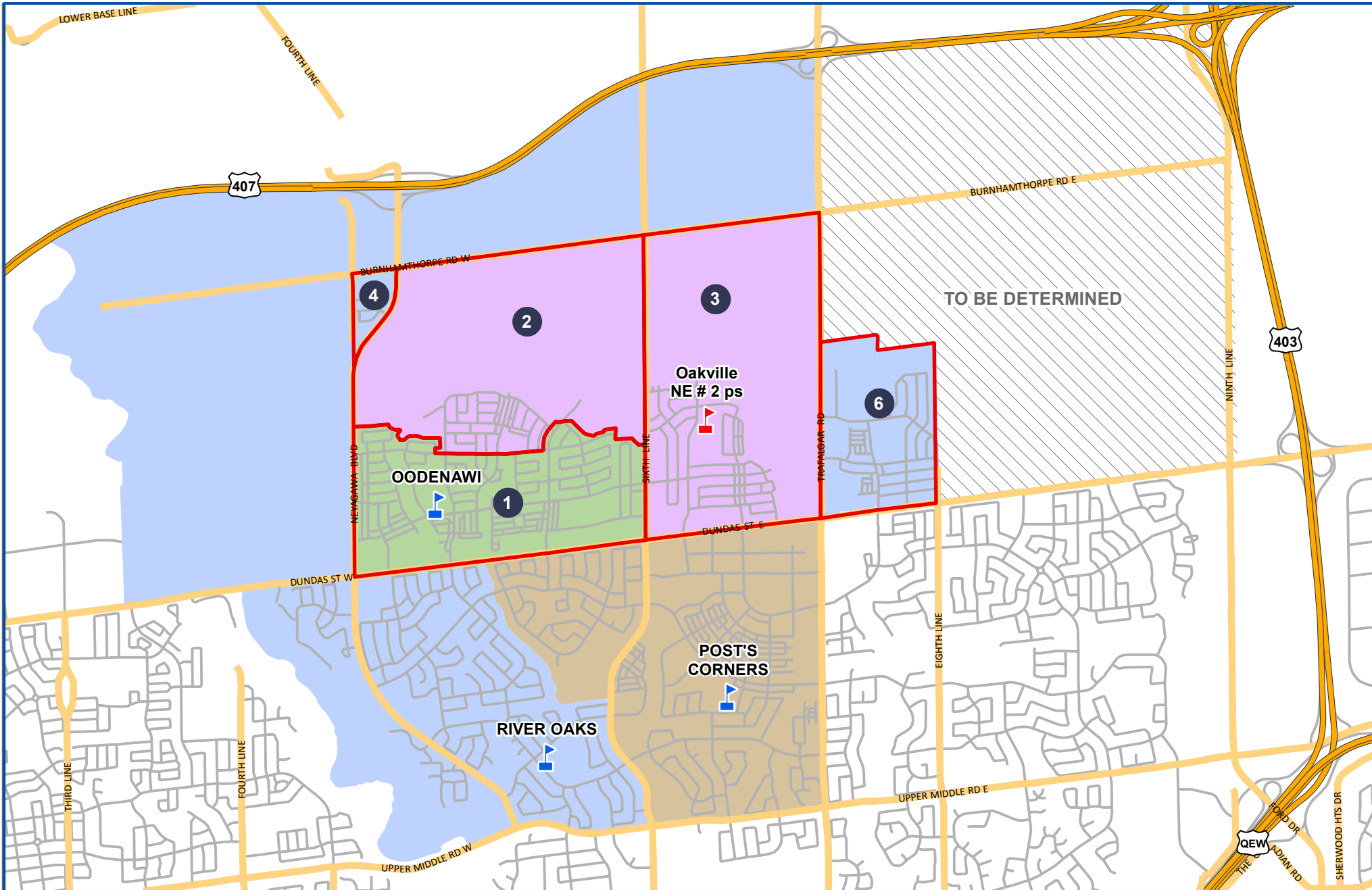

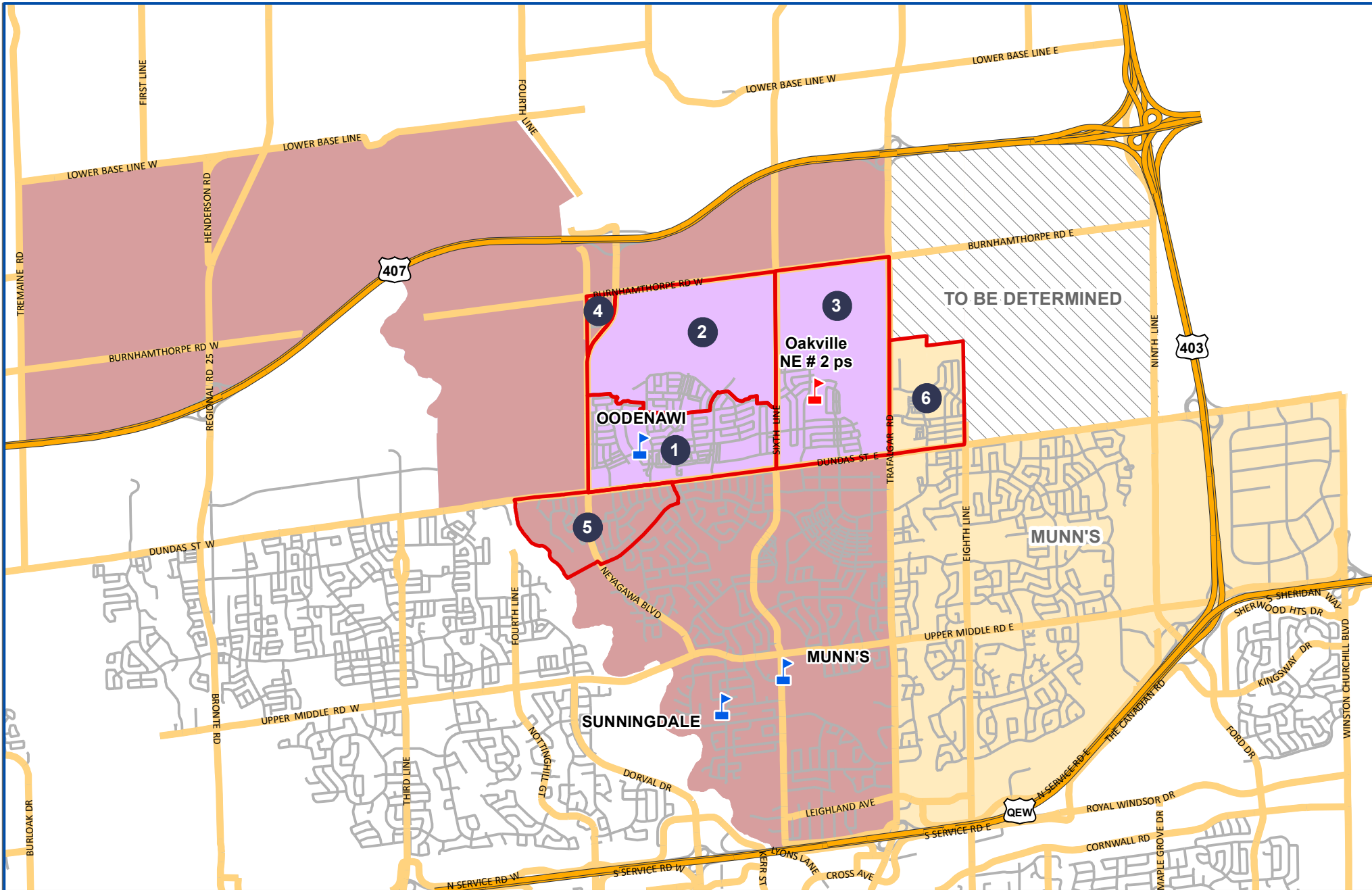
Scenario 14 a & 14 b English Program Boundary



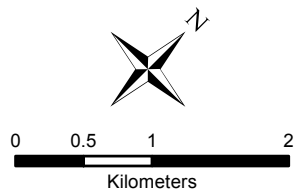

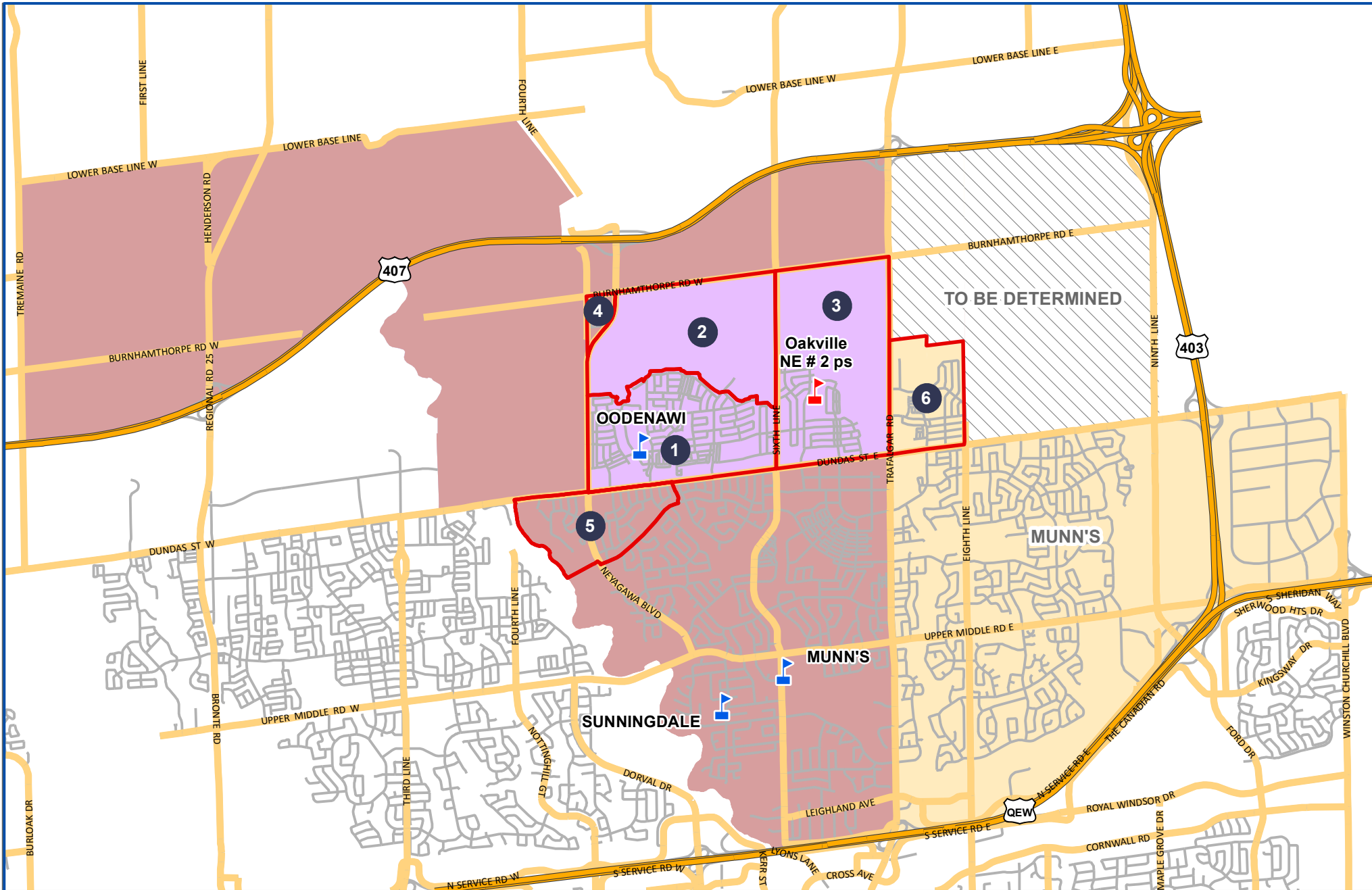
Scenario 15 English Program Boundary



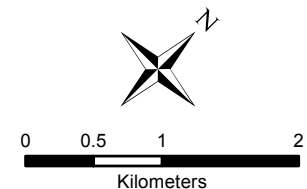
