


Option 1c - Impacts Frontenac PS, John T. Tuck PS, Tecumseh PS, Ryerson PS - Effective Sept. 2020

John T. Tuck PS becomes a K-6 school, K-6 boundary shrinks. Frontenac PS and Tecumseh PS 7 & 8 boundary and Ryerson PS K-6 boundary expansions.

Phased in starting with grade 7 in 2020, grade 8 in 2021.

Status Quo - No change to the boundary or projections for Pauline Johnson PS.

Frontenac PS (*K-8*): Grade 7 & 8 boundary expands to include Pauline Johnson PS. School enrolments are projected to increase to near 85% of OTG capacity. Available pupil places are expected to remain above 100 pupil places by 2021. Portables are not required.

John T. Tuck PS (*K-6*): K-6 boundary shrinks to south of New St. Students residing north of New St to be redirected to Ryerson PS. Grades 7 and 8 are directed to Tecumseh PS. School is expected to decline to below 70% by 2025. Available pupil places are expected to increase over 150 pupil places by 2023. Portables are not required.

Tecumseh PS (*K-8*): Grade 7 & 8 boundary expands to include Ryerson PS and John T. Tuck PS catchment. School enrolments are projected to increase to be above or near OTG capacity. Available pupil places are expected to decrease to under 50 pupil places by 2027. One to two portables are required for 2021 & 2022.

Ryerson PS (*K-6*): The boundary expands to include the John T Tuck PS area north of New St. School enrolments are projected to increase above 60% of OTG capacity by 2021. Available pupils places are expected to decrease under 200 pupil places by 2024. Portables are not required.

Redirections

John T Tuck PS grade 6 cohort to be directed to Tecumseh PS.

Pauline Johnson PS: Unified grade 6 cohort to be directed to Frontenac PS.

Ryerson PS: Unified grade 6 cohort to be directed to Tecumseh PS.

Tecumseh PS: Split grade 8 cohort to Nelson HS or Burlington Central HS.
