


Scenario 3 - Impacts Frontenac PS, John T. Tuck PS, Tecumseh PS, Ryerson PS - Effective Sept. 2020

Ryerson PS boundary expansion. Frontenac PS and Tecumseh PS 7 & 8 boundary expansion.

John T. Tuck PS K - 8 boundary shrinks. Phased out starting with grades K-5, north of New St.. North of New St grade 6's redirected to Tecumseh.

Ryerson PS K-5 expansion in 2020, K-5 expansion in 2020, grade 6 added in 2021.

Status Quo - No change to the boundary or projections for Pauline Johnson PS.

Frontenac PS (*K-8*): Grade 7 & 8 boundary expands to include Pauline Johnson PS. School enrolments are projected to increase to near 85% of OTG capacity. Available pupil places are expected to reman above 100 places. Portables are not required.

John T. Tuck PS (K-8): K-8 boundary shrinks in size to inlucde the catchments south of New St. Students that reside north of New St will be driected to Ryerson PS (K-6), Tecumseh PS or Frontenac PS (7 & 8). The school is expected to remain above 85%. of OTG capacity. Available pupil places are expected to increase over 50 pupil places by 2025. Portables are not required.

Ryerson PS (*K-6*): The boundary expands to include the John T. Tuck PS area north of New St and east of Walker's Line. School enrolments are projected to increase to near 65% of OTG capacity. Available pupil places are expected to decrease to under 200 pupil places by 2024. Portables are not required.

Tecumseh PS (*K-8*): Grade 7 & 8 boundary expands to include the proposed Ryerson PS catchment expansion. School enrolments are projected to increase to near 70% of OTG capacity. Available pupil places are expected to remain above 100 pupil places. Portables are not required.

Redirections

Pauline Johnson PS: Unified grade 6 cohort to be directed to Frontenac PS.

Ryerson PS: Unified grade 6 cohort to be directed to Tecumseh PS.
