RE: Boundary Review – Southeast Burlington (ERA 103)

Warrant:

At the February 19, 2014 Board meeting a report was presented outlining the current English enrolments and the 2014-15 projections for Pineland, Martin Street and E.W. Foster Public Schools.

As a triple grade configuration has been possible (due to 23 or fewer students enrolled in three consecutive grades) for two consecutive years the School Superintendent is to consider and may recommend for Board approval a boundary review.

RECOMMENDATION:


Be it resolved that the Halton District School Board approve a Boundary Review for ERA 103 which will address English Programming pressures at Pineland Public School effective for the 2015-16 school year; and THAT recommendations be presented to the Board no later than June 2014.

Rationale:


School	2013-2014 Grade 1-3 English Enrolments	2014 – 2015 Grade 1-3 English Projected Enrolments

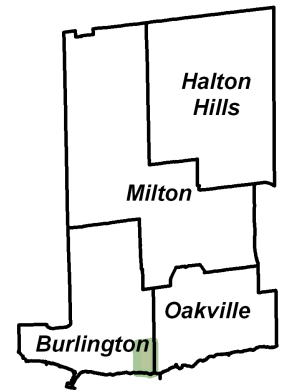
