Dear Neighbours and Friends of Martin Street Public School,

This letter will confirm the plan for the rebuild of Martin Street Public School, commencing in January 2016. The original Martin Street Public School building was built in 1920. This heritage portion of the school will be preserved and incorporated into the design of the newly built school on the current site. In March 2015, we gathered feedback from Martin Street Public School parents, neighbours and other community members regarding various options for the building and the accommodation of students for the duration of the construction phase. On May 20, 2015, the Halton District School Board reviewed this feedback and decided to temporarily move the Martin Street Public School students to Boyne Public School until the construction is completed in September, 2017.
